HONG KONG (AP)—A four-engine U.S. Navy transport plane with 11 persons aboard returned safely to Hong Kong today when one engine caught fire 15 minutes after it took off for Manila. The fire was immediately put out by an automatic extinguisher.

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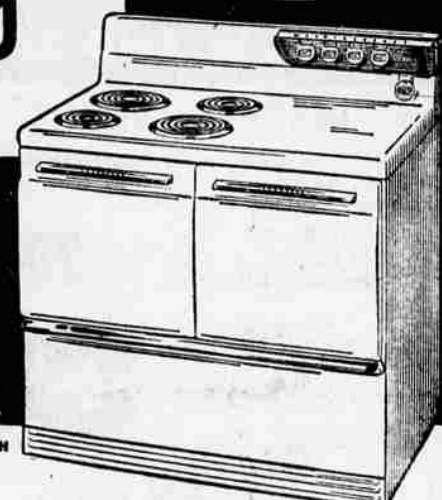
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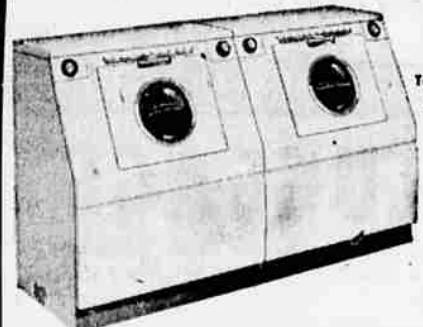
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
