

Pendleton Waitresses, Bartenders On Strike

PENDLETON (AP) — A strike of AFL waitresses and bartenders continued Saturday with nine restaurants and two bars affected in Pendleton.

Mrs. Verna Coffinberry, secretary of local 526 of the Culinary Alliance, said 120 persons were on strike for a 15-cent hourly wage increase. That would make the wage \$1 an hour. Employers have offered 90 cents.

AUTHORIZES LOAN

SALEM (AP) — Public Utilities Comm. Charles H. Helzel authorized the Portland Gas & Coke Co. recently to borrow \$14,000,000 to help finance its conversion to natural gas.

The company will begin using natural gas from the San Juan Basin next year.

The company was permitted to issue \$5,000,000 of 4% per cent sinking fund bonds, and to issue \$8,000,000 worth of promissory notes.

Electronic Gadgets May Soon Pep Up Oldsters

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Some bright day in the future a man who is old and weary may be pepped up by having electronic gadgets imbedded in his body, reports an electronics engineer.

This mechanized man idea is the theory of Dr. Ivan A. Getting, vice president in charge of engineering and research for Raytheon Manufacturing Co. He made his prediction recently in an address before the opening session of the 1955 Electronic Components Conference.

Dr. Getting told members of the electronics industry that electronic devices installed in the human body could step up weakened or worn-out nerve impulses, strengthen the heart and perform other work to restore normal bodily functions.

He admitted there is yet a lot of work to be done before the idea can become reality.

BROWNS VALLEY, Minn. (AP) — Seven Iowa persons, five of them children, drowned Friday when a wind storm capsized their fishing boat on Lake Traverse.

Dead are L.K. Doty, Hawarden, Iowa, and his three sons and Leslie Hout, Hawarden, and his daughter and a son.

Browns Valley is at the southern tip of Lake Traverse on the Minnesota-South Dakota border, about 200 miles west of Minneapolis.

The families arrived at a resort on the South Dakota side of the lake about 5:30 p.m. and immediately went out on the lake in a boat. A severe wind and rainstorm hit the area about 6 p.m.
