SUN VALLEY, Idaho (AP) — Loan company officials were told Friday that theirs was the fastest growing financial business in the nation.
Walter Drier, vice president of the U. S. Savings and Loan League, told the Pacific Northwest loan officials' meeting here that: "Five years ago the total assets of our business were a little less than 17 billion dollars. We have seen this amount double until today our assets may be placed conservatively at 33 billion dollars."

Natural Gas Rates Will Probably Be Reduced

WENATCHEE (AP) — A vice president of the Pacific Northwest Pipeline Co. says natural gas rates in the Pacific Northwest will be lower than in many parts of the country.
Robert J. Herring of Houston, Texas, told the Wenatchee Chamber of Commerce that the uniform rates in the region will be 40 per cent under rates in New England, 20 per cent under New York City and slightly under the rate for West Texas gas in San Francisco.
Herring said delivery of gas from the San Juan Basin of Colorado and New Mexico is expected July 1, 1955.

Too Much Money Brings Fine For Truck Driver

BAKER (AP) — Too much money in the rear of his truck—1,400 pounds too much—caused a \$28 fine for Donald L. Nelson, Denver, Friday.
He explained the armored truck he drove was carrying a load of money from the Denver mint to Portland. He said the load shifted between Ontario, Ore., and Baker, causing the overload on the rear axle.
Records showed the truck and its load weighed 58,700 pounds. Nelson and the two guards broke the seal on the truck, reshuffled the load, and left again for Portland, after paying the fine.

LUCK RUNS OUT

MOUND CITY, S.D. (AP) — Luck ran out for an Air Force radar observer who once lived to tell how he shot himself out of a closed canopy of a jet plane at low level.
Lt. Myron E. Farb, 28, formerly of St. Louis, Mo., and Airman 1-C Donald L. Chapman, 23, La Crosse, Wis., were killed yesterday when the light plane they were flying crashed in flaming wreckage near here.

Ancient Roman Law Invoked In Selection Of Jurors

NEW YORK (AP) — A lunchtime stroll past the U.S. Courthouse recently acquainted a number of New Yorkers with old Roman law, with 13 pedestrians winding up as prospective jurors.
By law, such prospective jurors—known as talesmen—may be selected at random outside a law court.
Federal Judge Edward J. Dimock directed the roundup of talesmen, the court having run out of prospects with only 10 jurors sworn in a narcotics case. Two strollers eventually ended up on the jury.
The federal talesman law, which had its origins in old Roman law, hasn't been invoked here for more than 20 years. But it is common enough in some parts of the nation.
Responses ranged from bewilderment to unprintable quotes.
"One gentleman, after being 'tapped' by a marshal, exploded: 'What kind of gag is this? I've got a ticket to sail to Europe tomorrow!'"
Said another man:
"This is like being kidnapped or shanghaied. It's almost worse than the Army. Before you know it you're on a truck and you're on your way."
One fleet-footed prospect dashed away, yelling: "I'm on my lunch hour. I've only got 20 minutes. Don't stop me!"
One talesman said he was on his way to the State Income Tax Bureau, and a court bailiff phoned the bureau to explain why the man would not be there.
"Can they do that?" asked the bureau man.
"Come over here on your lunch hour and see," invited the bailiff.
The tax examiner hung up.
Several women were stopped on the street, but they refused to be "impressed." That's legal under the ancient law, too, which gives them the right to refuse.
