Oregon Highway Commission Lists Possible Delays

SALEM (AP) — The Oregon Highway Commission listed the following construction projects and traffic delays Tuesday:

Warm Springs Highway — Minor delays between Wasco County line and Warm Springs Agency.

Columbia River Highway — Oiled detours for 20 miles between The Dalles Dam and Rufus; occasional minor delays and one-way traffic between 2 and 4.5 miles west of Pendleton.

The Dalles-California Highway — Oiled detours between Sherman and Willowdale.

Pacific Highway — Possible minor delays for 4 miles north of Myrtle Creek; possible delays at Rice Hill, 5 miles south of Yoncalla.

Coast Highway — Minor delays north of Gardiner; detour on old pavement between Clear Lake and Bel Lake; possible delays between 2 and 14 miles south of Port Orford.

Umpqua Highway — Road rough for 1.4 miles east of Reedsport.

Willamette Highway — Minor delay between 1 and 7 miles west of Oakridge.

Canada's Air Weapons Chief Relieved Of Job

OTTAWA (AP) — Canada's air weapons chief has been relieved of his job for what the government considers "highly inappropriate" statements. He said another world war appeared inevitable and the West could "beat the pants off" the Russians.

The remarks were made by Air Vice Marshal J. L. Plan, chief of the Royal Canadian Air Force Technical Services, in a speech last Thursday to a meeting of the Aviation Writers Assn. in Toronto.

Defense Minister Ralph Campney told Parliament yesterday that Plan had been removed from his job and named head of the RCAF Air Materiel Command. The minister said this would remove him from any association with policy matters.

Invites Adenauer

MOSCOW (AP) — The Soviet Union Tuesday invited West German Chancellor Adenauer to visit Moscow "in the nearest future" to discuss establishment of diplomatic relations between the Soviet Union and West Germany.
