

Portland Carpenters, Strike Halts \$100 Million Worth Of Building Construction

PORTLAND — An employer spokesman said Wednesday that 100 million dollars worth of building construction work here was being shut down because of a carpenters' strike.

Clell Harris, secretary for the AFL Carpenters Union, said he hadn't heard at mid-day about the shut down, but "that's what we wanted them to do."

The union started sending out pickets Wednesday to construction
