Grandmother Draws Two Years For Perjury

WASHINGTON (AP)—Turnabout witness Marie Natvig was sentenced this week to eight months to two years in prison for lying under oath as a government witness.

A marshal immediately took the 51-year-old gray haired grandmother into custody.

U. S. District Judge Alexander Holtzoff described the sentence as "moderate." He could have sent Mrs. Natvig to jail for up to 15 years on the three perjury charges on which she was convicted by a jury a month ago.

A jury convicted Mrs. Natvig May 16 of three charges of perjury. The indictment stemmed from her testimony as a Federal Communications Commission witness during an inquiry into the background of Edward Lamb, a Toledo lawyer, publisher and broadcasting executive.

Bill Authorizes Limited Sales Of Forest Lands

WASHINGTON (AP)—A bill to authorize sale of isolated or narrow projecting strips of national forest lands would provide a "simple solution" to a presently difficult administrative job, Rep. Coon (R-Ore) told a House Agriculture subcommittee.

A member of the National Forest Reservation Commission, he said there are numerous small forest tracts which are several miles removed from the main body of national forests.

Except where such lands have agricultural value, he said, disposal is either impossible or a long and tedious matter.

Where isolated parcels or narrow projecting strips of national forest land can be added to existing farm ownerships or private forest land management units, he said, "the economy of the area

and the development of private forestry enterprise will be substantially benefited."

Coon said he does not share apprehension voiced by Rep. Brooks (D-Tex) that the bill constitutes "an open invitation to the sale of forest lands."

Brooks earlier had described the bill as "undesirable legislation." He proposed numerous safeguards to restrict authority of the secretary of Agriculture under the bill.

Coon told the subcommittee "there isn't a chance for sale of the national forests" under the proposal. I would limit sales to isolated or projecting areas, he said. Most of the safeguards proposed by Brooks, he said, already are in the present laws.

The Oregon congressman said he has "no apprehension that the secretary of Agriculture will not

handle the problem with the best public interest constantly in mind. He has shown a desire to find ways to economize and yet provide for the most efficient management of the national forests."

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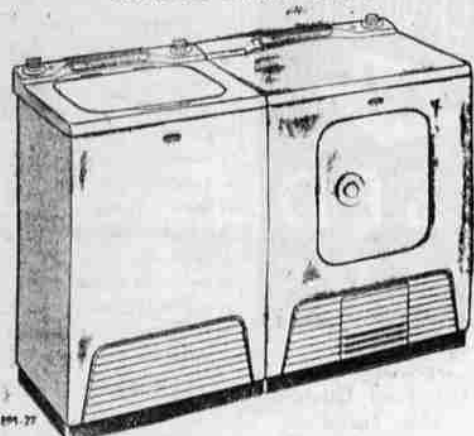


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
