Portland Hospitals Up Minimum Daily Rates

Nurses were among those receiving raises and the council said similar wage increases could be expected throughout the state.

Billy Graham Heard By 65,000 In Germany
NUERNBERG, Germany (AP)—American evangelist Billy Graham addressed his largest revival meeting crowd in Germany Saturday night—65,000, according to police estimates.
About 9,000 U.S. servicemen and their families were in the audience at the former Nazi party rally grounds here. At the conclusion of Graham's sermon, 6,000 persons—1,200 Americans among them—stepped forward at his urging to make "decisions for Christ."
