Committee Asks Firmer Hand Over Yugoslavia

WASHINGTON (AP)—The House Foreign Affairs Committee called last week for a firmer hand in making Yugoslavia observe agreements permitting American observers to see how it uses U. S. arms.

Otherwise, the committee warned in a report, there will be legislative curbs on future military aid to Marshal Tito's government.

The committee said it had been told Yugoslavia has "not been fully cooperative" in permitting American observers to see how it handles and maintains arms supplied under the foreign aid program. This is a customary requirement of all nations receiving military assistance.
