

Boeing Co. Gets Green Light For Jet Airliners

SEATTLE (AP) — The Boeing Airplane Co., given the green light by the Air Force for immediate

production of commercial jet airliners, readied a drive this week to capture the major share of the U. S. jet passenger plane business.

Air Secretary Talbot Wednesday notified Boeing it could begin building commercial versions of the prototype 707 while turning out jet tanker-transporters for the Air Force.

William E. Allen, Boeing president, announced:

"We are highly pleased. . . The Boeing Co. will now take immediate steps to negotiate firm contracts with the commercial airlines."

At a recent United Air Lines directors' meeting here, W. A. Patterson, president, said UAL expects to have 20 jet airliners in operation by 1960. He indicated they would be bought either from Boeing or the Douglas Aircraft Co., Santa Monica, Calif.

Douglas has announced that work has been started on such a plane but the Boeing 707 has been a familiar plane in the skies over the Puget Sound area many months, having made its first flight in May last year and having almost 200 hours of flight test time.

Allen promised delivery of the jet transports for scheduled commercial operation early in 1959. They will have an 80 to 135 passenger capacity, with a speed in the 550-miles-an-hour range, and will be capable of nonstop transcontinental and transoceanic flights.

School District Ordered On Desegregated Basis

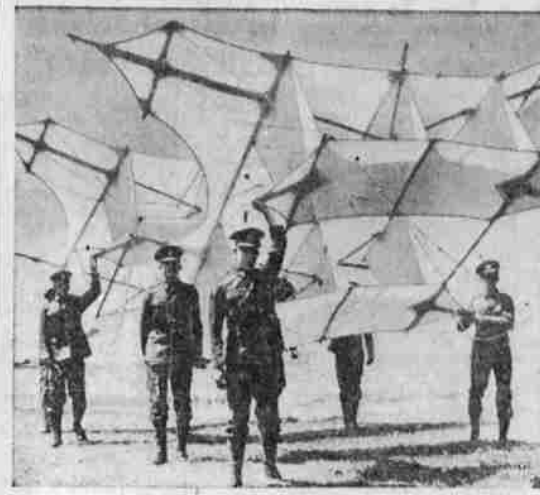
COLUMBIA, S. C. (AP) — A three-judge Federal Court has ordered Summerton School District trustees to proceed "with all deliberate speed" to operate on a racially non-segregated basis.

The trustees were enjoined from refusing on account of race to admit any child to any school "from and after such time as they may have made the necessary arrangements" for ending segregation.

The order was handed down less than 1 1/2 hours after a hearing in one of the five cases in which the Supreme Court held that racially segregated public schools are unconstitutional. The hearing was necessitated by the Supreme Court's May 31 decree remanding the case for action in line with its decision.

Crown Zellerbach Plans To Build Plywood Plant

PORTLAND (AP) — One of the nation's biggest pulp and paper producers, Crown Zellerbach Corp., is going into the plywood business.

E. P. Stamm, a vice president, announced recently that work will start immediately on dredging and foundation for a green veneer mill at St. Helens, northwest of here.

He said the plant will cost \$300,000 but that the firm would spend another 1 1/2 million dollars if it goes through with tentative plans to expand into production of finished plywood.

TRAFFIC TOLL IS LESS

SALEM (AP) — Oregon's traffic toll for the first six months of the year stands at 15 less than for the same period of the previous year, the state Traffic Safety Division said here.

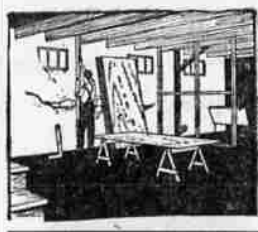
