

Senate Group Restores Foreign Aid Money

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Senate Appropriations Committee Tuesday voted to restore some of the cuts made by the House in funds for President Eisenhower's foreign aid program.

No official announcement of the vote was made, but several senators reported privately on them. The biggest restoration was a \$32,800,000 reduction made by the House in defense support — economic aid which has military usefulness — for friendly nations in Asia.

However, the principal House cuts, \$20 million for world-wide military assistance, and 100 million in a special fund requested by Eisenhower for Asian economic development, were put over until a later session.

104th Infantry Headed For Full-Force Status

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—The Sixth Army announced today it has been authorized to designate the 104th Reserve Infantry Division of Washington and Oregon. The division now is designated a cadre unit and is authorized to maintain only a skeleton organization.

The Army said the redesignation is in keeping with a program to reorganize certain Army Reserve units for duties which would be required of them in the event of mobilization.
