New Wage Boost Floor Seen Blow To Small Business

WASHINGTON (AP)—All Oregon and Washington members of the House voted this week for the bill to increase the minimum wage from 75 cents to \$1 an hour. But at least one had his reservations.

Rep. Coon (R-Ore), who voted against the proposal in committee, had implied in House debate he would oppose the bill. He supported various amendments all unsuccessful, designed to lower the figure, but went along with the higher figure on final passage.

In the debate Coon said increasing the minimum wage to \$1 will defeat the very purpose for which the minimum wage law was first written, for it will destroy many small businesses and thereby throw out of employment these fringe workers who depend on the small businessman for their jobs.

He said his Eastern Oregon congressional district has always paid high wages and workers there needed no protection under the minimum wage law.

Following a published news item of the arrest of a John Gilbert McGrover, also of Sutherland, on a reckless driving charge, the union representative reports his friends have been calling him and offering funds for bail or fine.

After being the only McGrover in Sutherland for 40 years, the business agent says the population growth of that city is creating embarrassing complications.
