Atomic Cannons, Super Rockets Go To Far East

WASHINGTON — The Army announced Thursday it is sending a half dozen atomic cannons and a number of long range atomic rockets to its forces in the Far East.

The announcement did not specify where in the Far East the nuclear weapons would go except to say they would be under 8th Army Command.

However, informed sources said the 280 mm. guns would go to Army forces on Okinawa and the rockets to forces in Japan.

The 63rd Field Artillery Battalion, an atomic gun outfit which recently completed training at Fort Bragg, N. C., has been assigned to the 8th Army.

The "Honest John" rocket outfit is the 5th Field Artillery Battalion, which has been training at Fort Sill, Okla.

The atomic cannon, it was understood, would arrive in Okinawa Friday.

The Army said the nuclear weapons were being sent to the Far East as "part of established United States policy to make available to its forces overseas the most modern developments in military weapons."

Batteries of the huge guns have been in Europe for more than a year. The guns being sent to Army forces on Okinawa, however, are the first to go to the Far East.

The atomic cannon, mounted on a base slung between two power tractors, can be transported in large landing craft.

It would be possible for instance, in event of Chinese Communist attack in the Far East, to transport these cannon to beachheads on the mainland for use in support of landing forces and bombardment of tactical targets, at least 50 of the guns, six battalions, or 36 guns, are in Europe.

Neither the atomic cannon nor the rocket will be sent to U. S. forces in Korea. Terms of the Korean truce forbid a buildup of armament in North of South Korea.
