

**Ike Should Oust Talbott, Morse Tells Senators**

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Morse (D-Ore) told the Senate Thursday that President Eisenhower should fire Harold E. Talbott as Air Force secretary "forthwith." He said Talbott's outside business activities constituted "a very serious case of malfeasance in government office" and added: "If this administration thinks that it is going to get the American people to swallow this mess of corruption, it is going to find that

the people are going to gag." Morse called Talbott's partnership in Paul M. Mulligan & Co., a business management engineering firm, while serving as Air Force secretary, "an outrageous violation of the spirit and intent of the conflict-of-interest statutes." "A strong case can be made in the courtroom" against Talbott "if the Department of Justice was interested in ferreting out corruption." The Senate investigations sub-

committee has just finished hearings on Talbott's business affairs. The inquiry centered on Mulligan contracts with firms doing defense business, and on Talbott's efforts to promote business for the firm. The secretary testified he had not used the influence of his office, and stressed the terms of his arrangement with the Mulligan firm to cut him out of profits on any business with concerns which were predominantly in defense work.

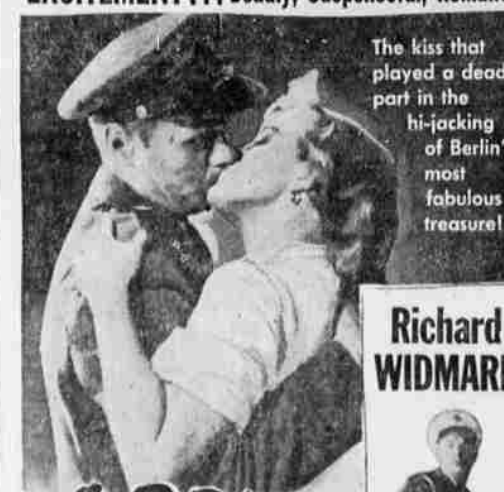
