Two More Rain Gauges Installed In County

Recording rain gauges have been installed near the head of the west fork of Cow Creek and on the divide between Jackson Creek and the South Umpqua River east of Coyote Point Lookout.

The gauges are operated by weight-driven clocks and will run 30 days without rewinding, according to Ben B. Irving, head of the Douglas County Water Resources Survey Office. The installations will record 24 inches of rainfall.

Horsepower Expected To Defeat 'Nightcrawler'

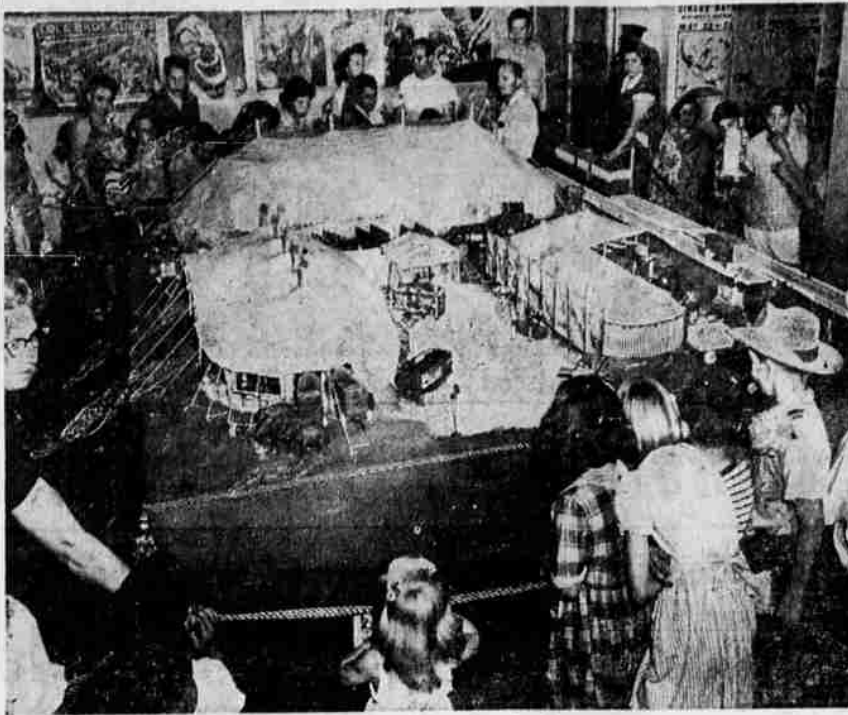

Surprisingly, men don't slow down much at the really long distances. Emil Zatopek went a 1 x 1.5 miles in 23 minutes 8.4 seconds. Jim Peters took 2 hours 18 minutes 40.2 seconds to run 26 miles 385 yards — the marathon. Both Zatopek and Peters ran 12.85 miles per hour.

Men slow down at greater distances. John Landy ran the mile in 3 minutes 53 seconds, a velocity of 15.13 miles per hour. Roseburg High School's ace miler, Mark Robbins, turned in a time of 4 minutes 27.4 seconds last spring, or 14.55 mph.

Data For Outlet Dam Turned In

Tentative data for a regulating dam on Siltcoos Lake outlet have been filed with the office of the state engineer, calling for a structure to hold water at eight feet above sea level.

The Port Umpqua Courier reports the outlined proposal calls for a structure 130 feet wide with a spillway and a 5 by 5-foot regulating gate and fish ladders. It would be made of sheet steel piling set in an arc.

The effect would be to hold the water in Siltcoos Lake at a level of eight feet. The summer low level is three feet and the winter high is 14 feet, according to Asst. State Engineer C. L. Wheeler. The storage provided in conjunction with Washink and Tahkenitch lakes would be 21,000 acre feet or about 7,000 million gallons, Wheeler said.

Long Bell's water right application calls for 22 cubic second feet from the three lakes. Menasha Plywood Corp. also has a filing for water rights on Tahkenitch alone. It calls for 46.42 feet. The two applications are entirely separate.

The Courier reports that L. O. Bell President J. D. Leland said his company's program would stabilize lake levels at a mean point and that even at a maximum pumping during the dry season would not affect this level more than four inches at any one time.

Prisoner Issue Easily Settled, War With U. S. Not Wanted, Chou Says

TOKYO (AP) — Red China's Premier Chou En-Lai declared Saturday night the "question" of the small number of American civilians in Communist China "can be easily settled" at the Geneva talks starting Monday.

But Chou made no mention of the 11 airmen Red China imprisoned on charges of "spying." Chou's lengthy foreign policy speech was broadcast by the Peiping Radio and monitored here.

U. S. government officials have said 51 Americans are held by China, including 40 civilians and 11 fliers. Twenty-five civilians are reported in jail; 3 under house arrest and 12 are refused exit visas.

Chou said "the Chinese people want no war with the United States" so the question of a cease-fire between China and the United States does not arise.

At the same time Chou demanded return of "several thousands" of Chinese students he said are still in the United States.
