

Registration Of Alleged Red Outfit Demand

WASHINGTON (AP) — Atty. Gen. Brownell Monday asked the Subversive Activities Control Board to order the American Peace Crusade, headquartered in New York City, to register as a Communist-front organization.

The attorney general two years ago put the American Peace Crusade on his list of subversive organizations.

The registration proceeding filed against the group said that "American Women for Peace" and the "National Labor Conference for Peace," similarly listed, have now merged into the American Peace Crusade.

The petition alleged that the group is "directed, dominated and controlled by the Communist Party and has been operated primarily for giving aid and support to the party."

The proceeding before the SACB is the 15th involving "front" groups.

1,500 Portland Children Receive Polio Inoculation

PORTLAND (AP) — Nearly 1,500 school children in Portland received their second inoculation of polio vaccine Monday as a week-long program opened to complete the series here.

Additional clinics will be open this week at city schools, with second inoculations scheduled in Lane, Marion and Multnomah counties later this week. These were the only areas where the program had not been completed.

RULES HEART ATTACK

An inquest was ordered, said Deputy Coroner Glen E. Bodell, because an attempt had been made to conceal the death for several hours.

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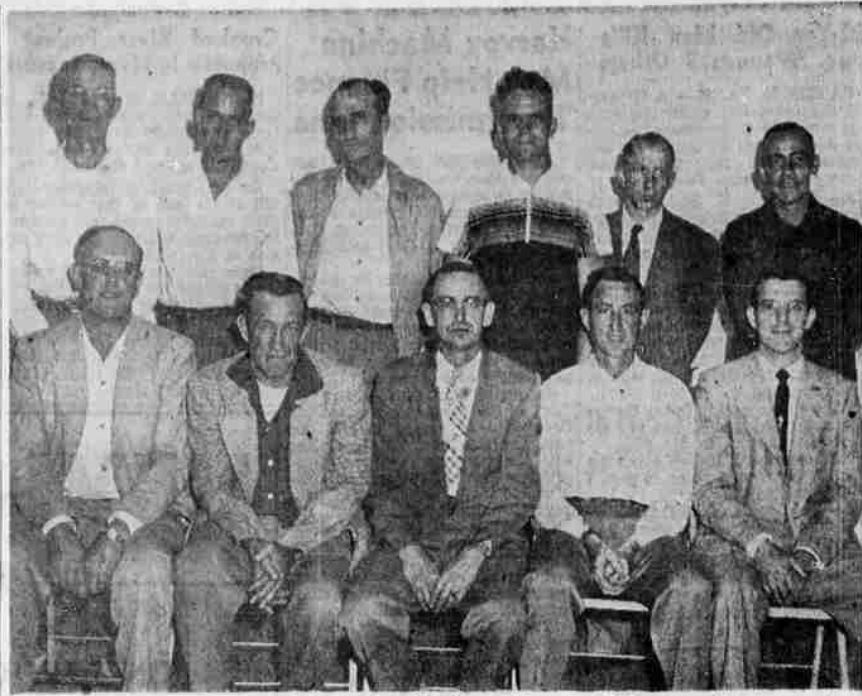

Free Polio Shots Voted In Bitter House Session

WASHINGTON (AP) — After an angry row the House Monday passed a bill to provide free polio vaccine for the nation's needy children—an estimated 24 million of them.

The bill, passed on a voice vote, would authorize up to 45 million dollars to vaccinate roughly one-fourth of unvaccinated children under 20.

A far more liberal bill passed by the Senate would give free vaccine to all children under 20, if the states asked for it. This could cost up to 130 million dollars. The House immediately sent the bill to conference to compromise differences.

The House bill opened the door to such bitter partisan debate that Speaker Rayburn (D-Tex) at one point called a 45-minute recess.

The bill would provide funds for three shots of Salk polio vaccine for an estimated 15 1/2 million children under 20 who might need financial help. It would provide also for a third shot for about 8 1/2 million children in first and second grades who already are receiving two free shots from the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis.

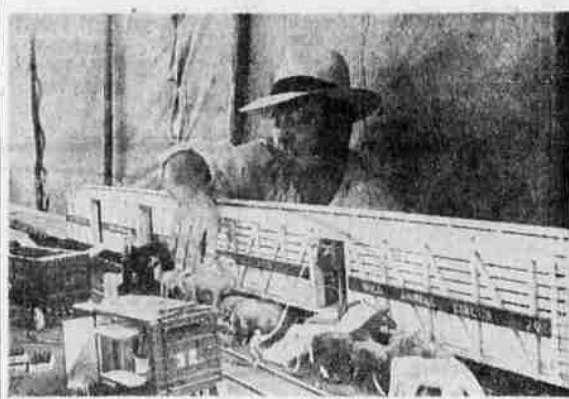
Denies Charge Refuted

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Tough Housing Problem Solved By Army Matron

FT. RILEY, Kan. (AP) — Blue-eyed, auburn-haired Emilie Turney has just finished the task of moving her household — some 5,000 miles.

Emilie is an Army wife whose husband is among the thousands of soldiers participating on Operation Gyroscope. In this gigantic move, 9,000 members of the 1st Infantry Division in Germany are trading places with the 10th Division at Ft. Riley.

The vanguard of the 1st Division arrived here Monday.

Today Emilie, her two children and her husband, C.W.O. Vale Turney, are established in a rented house in nearby Junction City — and already are talking about buying a home of their own.

Emilie's task of setting up a new household in the United States has an added complication. In addition to her household duties and caring for her 16-month-old daughter Patricia and 4-month-old son Billy, she has a language barrier.

A German girl, she speaks and understands a little English but her husband still must interpret fast-moving conversation for her.

She loves the supermarket. "It's good, fine. You can buy anything there," she said.

Service Inferior
She added that over here "everything's bigger — the shops, the cafes — but the service is not equal to Germany. A young man there has an apprenticeship — studies three years to be a waiter. Dresses cost less here, but they're made better in Germany, I think."

With her husband's coaching plus special classes at Ft. Riley to help the wives adjust to life in America, the Turneys figure
