Question On Red Relations Dodged By Three Actors

NEW YORK — Three Broadway actors refused Monday to answer questions about possible Communist relationships at a hearing of the House Un-American Activities Committee.

Two of them, Stanley Prager and John Randolph, cited the first situation. The other, George Tyne declared the committee "has no right to invade my inner beliefs."
The men were the first witnesses called as the committee launched a hearing here on alleged Communist influence in the entertainment industry.

Tyne testified he was blacklisted in Hollywood in 1951 after it became known the committee was seeking to question him.

Rep. Francis E. Walter (D-Pa.) chairman of the House committee said at the hearing opened that it would seek to identify entertainment figures "who are or were Communists."
He said the object also is to expose those "who are using or did use their influence to promote the objects of the Communist party within the entertainment field."
