THE FIVE FAMILIES FORMING TODAY'S feature society page are among the many newcomers selecting Roseburg to make their home.

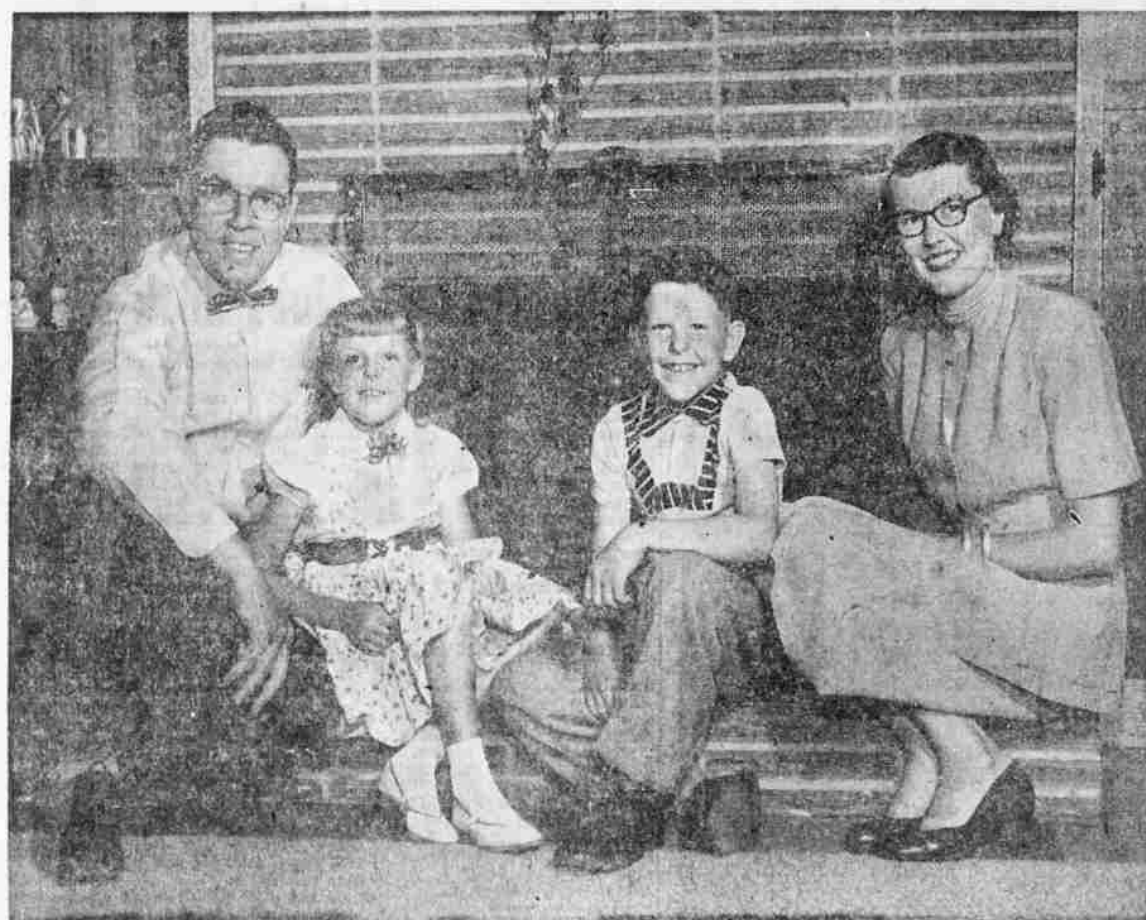
