

Thornton Asks Patterson Make

SALEM (AP) — Atty. Gen. Robert Y. Thornton demanded Thursday that Gov. Paul Patterson make public the Liquor Commission's report on charges that commission employees accepted gifts and bribes from distillers.

His statement came a day after Marion County Circuit Judge George R. Duncan denied Thornton's request for a court order that would have directed the commission to give Thornton a copy of the report and other evidence.

Thornton also said the governor should order lie detector tests for commission employees who were accused of taking bribes and gifts.

Thornton said the secret report, written by Portland attorney Robert Maguire, contains evidence that commission employees solicited bribes ranging from \$40 to \$10,000, that bribes were accepted, and evidence of perjury by commission employees.

All of the employees involved are still working for the commission, Thornton said.
