Trainee Exam Set To Select Veterinarians

A civil service examination for veterinarian trainees has been announced for filling positions paying \$3,670 a year. Jobs to be filled are with the Agricultural Research Service of the Department of Agriculture and are located throughout the United States.

Appointments to these trainee positions will be made to junior students of veterinary medicine for on-the-job training during their

summer vacation period. When the student trainee is graduated from a veterinary college, he will be eligible for a position with the Agricultural Research Service as veterinarian, \$4,380 a year.

To qualify, applicants must have completed 4 years of veterinary medicine, one year of which may have been in pre-veterinary medicine. Competitors will also be required to take a written test.

Applications must be filed not later than November 1, 1955, with the Executive Secretary, Board of Civil Service Examiners, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington 25, D. C.

The Rev. David F. Siemens has taken the pastorate of the Green Community Church, succeeding the Rev. Gordon A. Wood.

The new pastor and his wife most recently were in Hawaii, where he was field director for the Missionary Church Assn., and pastor of the Koloa church on the island of Kauai.

The Siemens spent about four years in the islands, following seven years at Ft. Wayne, Ind., where the Rev. Mr. Siemens was foreign secretary for the association.

Prior to that time, the minister was superintendent of the U.S. western district for the association. A good share of his 35 years in the ministerial work was in South America, however, spending many years in Argentina, Paraguay and Ecuador. Starting with work with jungle Indians, he later became director of the Bible Institute of Ambato, Ecuador.

The Siemens has two married children, David Jr. and Marilyn Lindquist. Their son is now teaching at Culter Academy, Los Angeles, and working on his doctorate at UCLA. Their son-in-law is working for a master's degree at Trinity Seminary, Chicago.

The Rev. Robert Hempel of the Roseburg Ministerial Assn. will be among those scheduled to appear on the program.

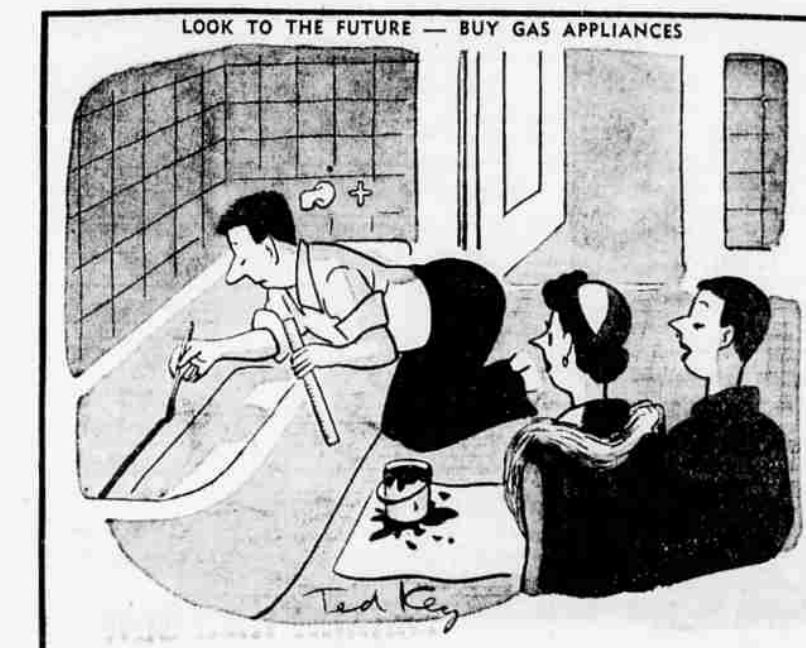
MORE AID FOR EGYPT
