

Norman Thomas Dated For Address At Knife-Fork Club

Norman Thomas, militant believer in world-controlled disarmament and the learned fellow who holds a world record as a candidate for president of the United States, will be the next speaker to address the Umpqua Valley Knife and Fork Club.

Thomas, who is a "young 70" and looks it, will be featured at the Nov. 1 meeting of the club at the Roseburg Elks Ballroom, according to President Harold Augustus.

Thomas headed the Socialist Party for nearly a quarter of a century and was its standard bearer on six occasions. He has appeared on the Town Hall Meeting of the Air more times than any other person.

Born at Marion, Ohio, he carried papers for Warren G. Harding and was a student at Princeton under Woodrow Wilson. In addition to having been graduated by Princeton University, which

has bestowed upon him an honorary degree of doctor of letters, Thomas holds a degree from Union Theological Seminary.

Margaret Still Mulls Decision About Wedding

LONDON (AP) — The impression grows that 25-year-old Princess Margaret still had not made up her mind definitely whether to marry Peter Townsend, 40, a Royal Air Force group captain and the divorced father of two sons.

The Rev. Douglas Lockhart, rector of old St. Paul's Episcopal Church of Scotland, spoke out strongly against a marriage in a sermon in Edinburgh.

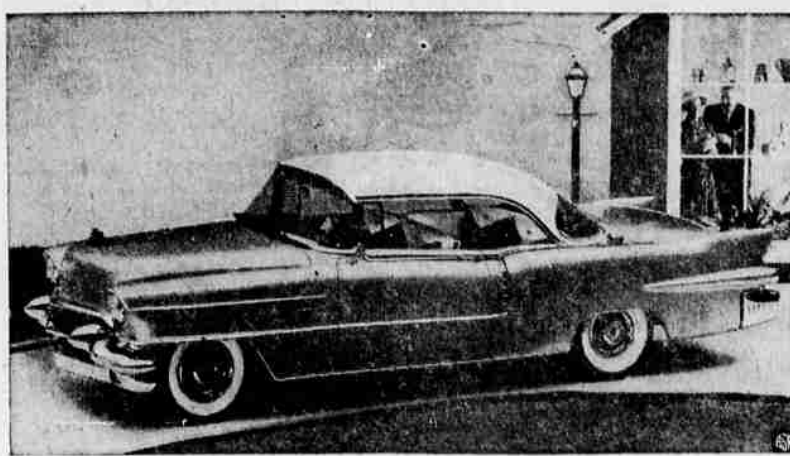
"No one has yet any right to assume that Princess Margaret intends to marry Group Capt. Townsend for there has been no official announcement to that effect."

"But if she were to make any such decision she would be taking a step which she is perfectly well aware to be contrary to the law of Christ and his church."

The views of her sister and brother-in-law about sanctity and the permanence of the marriage bond are well known.

Queen Elizabeth II is believed to be sympathetic toward her younger sister in the matter but she also is believed to be cautioning her to give second thoughts to any plan of marrying Townsend.

The Duke of Edinburgh, Elizabeth's husband, is reported to be firmly against such a marriage.

Dynamite Blast Scares Seals; Fishing Good

WALDPORF (AP) — Salmon fishing was pretty fair in Alsea Bay Friday but no one would say who touched off a dynamite blast that scared a herd of seals away.

The blast, which shook the town early Friday, was disclosed by investigation to have been set off on an island in the bay.

It was right about where a herd of seals had been congregating every morning for a week. The seals, which normally bypass the bay in their forays up and down the coast between Sea Lions Caves south of here and Seal Rock and other points to the north, came into

the bay when a good salmon run started.

Fishing Thursday was poor and fishermen blamed the seals. Then came the Friday morning blast, the seals left and fishermen said luck was much better.

No bodies of seals were reported seen. Whether the seals would be back was an unanswered question Saturday.

Also unanswered was the question of who placed the dynamite and set it off.

Barrier To Negro Troops Asked At Baton Rouge

BATON ROUGE (AP) — Local chapters of Southern Gentlemen, concerned about "black troops" in Baton Rouge, today considered a proposal to put the city off limits to Negro soldiers on leave from gigantic Army maneuvers next month.

J. B. Easterly, president of the statewide secret pro-segregation society, told delegates to the first convention Sunday that local chapters will have to decide the issue.

The Army and Air Force begin

Exercise Sagebrush at Camp Polk, La. Nov. 1. The maneuvers, to include about 140,000 troops, are the largest since World War II.

Robertson said he had seen nearly 2,000 mixed troops heading for the maneuver area in the last two days.

"I've heard that mayors are being told their cities will be designated leave centers for the maneuver troops," he said, and added Baton Rouge, a city of 130,000, will be "one of the first."

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Police Still Lack Clues To Killers Of Schoolboys

CHICAGO (AP) — Police today pressed their relentless search for the brutal slayers of three schoolboys after the father of one of the victims joined in the hunt for helpful information.

Malcolm Peterson, father of 14-year-old Robert Peterson, one of the victims, spent an hour last night flagging down buses near his home in an effort to secure information.

The naked, battered bodies of young Peterson, John Schuessler, 13, and his brother Anton, 11, were found seven days ago in Robinson Woods, west of the city limits. Police said the youths apparently waged a terrific struggle before being murdered.

Thus far the police investigation, already one of Chicago's most extensive, has failed to produce concrete results.

More than 100,000 persons have been interviewed and 23 square miles combed since the bodies were found Tuesday.

The Chicago detective bureau received a telegram from Mrs. J. H. Lopez of Cedartown, Ga., offering a \$1,000 reward for capture of the killer or killers. She explained that she had read about the case.

Her offer raised the reward total to \$6,700. Mayor Richard J. Daley plans to ask the City Council to post \$10,000 in reward cash.

Mr. and Mrs. Howard Bird returned Monday evening from a four-day hunting trip in Eastern Oregon, where each one of them killed a buck.

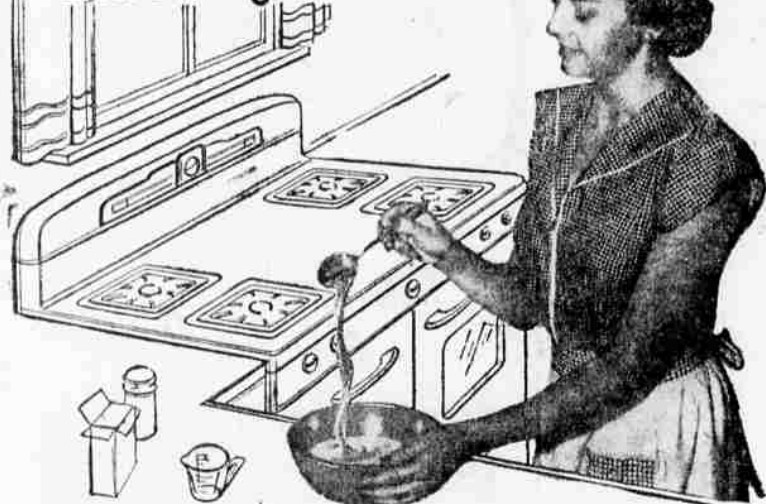
