Hunters Take Big Toll Ducks, Geese On Opening

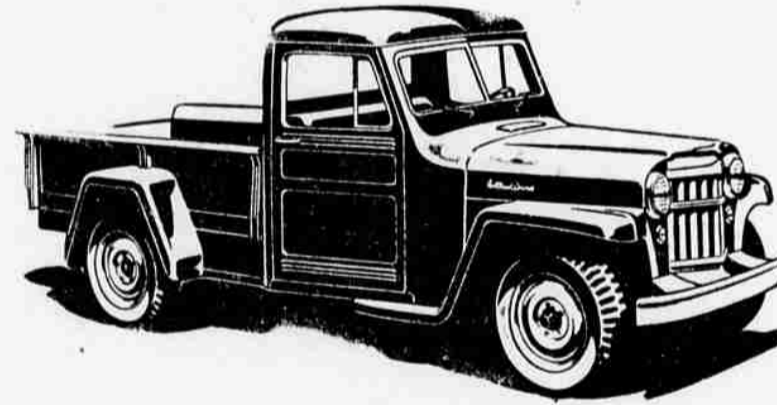

Farm Audience Cheers Demand To Oust Benson









