At first it was feared she had suffered a heart attack, but a coroner taken at Receiving Hospital did not confirm the original diagnosis of possible coronary occlusion.

Dr. Norman Goldston described her condition as "good" several hours after her collapse, and the 35-year-old actress was taken to Henry Ford Hospital for additional tests.

Miss Lake, who made the "peeka-bo" hair-do famous in the 1940s, has been appearing in the stage play, "The Little Hut," at Detroit's Shubert Theater.
