

1955 Christmas Seal Sale Starts In Douglas County

The 1955 Christmas Seal Sale started Wednesday. If Douglas County residents individually buy more seals than any other similarly populated area throughout the nation, they'll win themselves a full-scale Hollywood motion picture premiere.

The national contest is set up like this, according to the county's Tuberculosis and Health Assn. Executive Secretary Mrs. E. B. Tauscher.

1. The contest starts Wednesday and ends Nov. 23.

2. The winning area is determined on the percentage of population contributing "through mail sales" during the first seven days of the sale for the geographic area served by a particular association.

3. Participating associations will telegraph the number of contributors by no later than midnight, Nov. 23, to national headquarters in New York City.

Population figures used to determine the winning area come from an estimate made Jan. 1, 1955.

In 1954 Douglas County placed sixth in number of contributors, per population, in Oregon. Mrs. Tauscher hopes to skyrocket the figure to national prominence, as do the scores of volunteers who help the Douglas chapter.

Some 10 organizations and countless individuals prepared the seals for mailing. This morning 6,000 letters containing seals were delivered to residences.

Jury Selection Starts In Sherry Fong Trial

PORTLAND — Selection of a jury to try Sherry Fong started in circuit court Tuesday. It was the third time that had been done.

Charged jointly with her husband, Wayne Fong, in the death of her friend and occasional baby sitter, Diane Hank, she was convicted last summer. Judge Alfred P. Dobson set aside the conviction.

A second trial began but was declared a mistrial because of what the judge called improper comment made to jurors by lawyers for both sides.

Once this jury is selected it will be locked up, even over the Thanksgiving holiday, because Judge Dobson said public interest in the case is such that "some persons might try to get to members of the jury" if they were allowed to go home.

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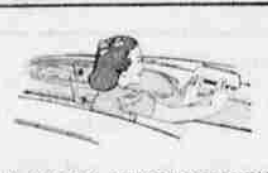
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
