Thanksgiving Day Turkey Dinner Cost Up Slightly
PORTLAND (AP)—The traditional Thanksgiving Day turkey dinner will cost slightly more than it did last year.
Most butcher shops quoted turkeys Friday at 57 cents a pound for the popular 10-18 pound weights. The price was 49 cents a pound for heavier turkeys.
A year ago the 10-18 pound turkey cost 53 cents a pound and the heavier birds 43-45 cents.
Hams were quoted at 6 to 10 cents cheaper than last year. They were selling at 49 cents a pound in leading markets.
