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2 Oakland Men Lodged In Jail

Two Oaklanders, Levi Willis, 21, and Edwin Douglas Fennell, 18, were lodged in the county jail under 30-day sentences Monday after they pleaded guilty before Sutherland Municipal Judge J. C. Irwin. Willis pleaded guilty to destroying public property and to escaping from custody. In addition to the 30-day term, he was fined \$100. Fennell was fined \$200 in addition to the jail sentence. He was charged with being illegally in possession of liquor and with drunken driving.

Sutherland police had trouble with Willis after his arrest Saturday night. Willis tore up the plumbing in his jail cell, broke a chain on a lock and gained entry to the City Hall office, police said. Willis was captured again, however, before he could get completely out of the building.

SUITS DISMISSED

OKLAHOMA CITY — Two \$10,000 slander suits against an Air Force officer for profanity allegedly used in lecturing two enlisted men were dismissed by Federal Judge W. H. Wallace.

Air Force sources said they were the first suits of their kind ever filed.

Senate Appropriations Head Wants Federal Agencies To Ask More Timber Money

WASHINGTON — Chairman Hayden (D-Ariz.) of the Senate Appropriations Committee hopes government agencies ask for more money this year to finance sale of government-owned timber.

In a letter to Sen. Morse (D-Ore), Hayden said timber sale appropriations will receive his "special attention" during consideration of budget requests of the Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Forest Service.

Pacific Coast Seafarers Get \$25 Month Raise

SAN FRANCISCO — A master contract giving 6,000 Pacific Coast seafarers a \$25 a month increase became effective Tuesday for two AFL maritime unions.

The Sailors Union of the Pacific and the Marine Cooks and Stewards union agreed with the Pacific Maritime Assn. Monday to make the contract effective although a third union, the AFL Marine Firemen, has not yet okayed it.

The seamen and cooks and stewards have accepted a provision of the new contract incorporating into regular base pay a 56-hour week at sea. Previously "penalty payments" were made for 16 hours beyond a 40-hour week at sea. Firemen will continue to work under the old rate until new contract terms are agreed on with the shipowners.

Headquarters Of YMCA Moved Into Grange Hall

The Roseburg YMCA has moved to new quarters in the Grange Hall, 520 Spruce St.

Following the weekend move, the "Y" officially opened its new doors Monday. Secretary Don Naden says the new location offers the YM about three times the space in the Army where the organization had been located. He plans to increase youth work. The new office has meeting space for clubs and committees. The YMCA phone number remains the same. It is OR 3-3536.

Tear Gas, Batons Used To Break Up Rioting

NICOSIA, Cyprus — Troops used tear gas and batons Tuesday to break up sporadic bursts of teen-age rioting. Authorities closed all secondary schools until order is restored.

Windows in the government tourist office were broken and four persons were arrested. A campaign to save Michael Karaolis, 22-year-old Greek-Cypriot clerk sentenced to death for murdering a policeman in Cyprus, spread throughout Greece and Crete.

TO RETURN TO SCHOOL

A 17-year-old Roseburg youth was ordered returned to MacLaren School for Boys at Woodburn Monday by Circuit Judge Charles S. Woodrich. The youth was on parole from the school when he was charged about two months ago with forgery. While the case was still under consideration, the youth was charged with stealing auto batteries.

Canyonville Man Meted Three Years In State Pen

James Dumont, 24, Canyonville, has been sentenced to three years in the state penitentiary by Circuit Judge Frank Heid for the theft of an auto from Springfield. Dumont was sentenced in Eugene. He admitted taking the car in October. It was wrecked as Dumont travelled south on Highway 99.

COAST MAN LODGED

Thomas Cleve McNamara, 40, Reedsport, was lodged in the county jail Monday after receiving a 60-day sentence for vagrancy from Robert H. Goodwin, Reedsport justice of the peace. McNamara was brought to Roseburg by a deputy sheriff and a Reedsport officer.



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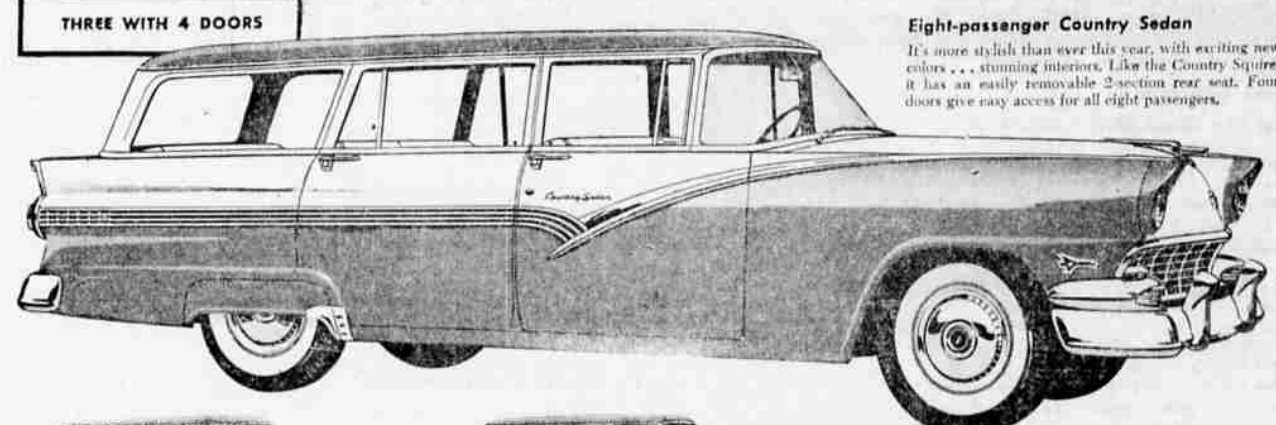
