Non-Farm Employment Is Down From September

SALEM — There were 250,390 persons working in non-farm jobs in the Portland-Vancouver area in October, the Oregon Unemployment Compensation Commission said Wednesday.

That was 7,000 more than in October, 1954, and a drop of only 1.4 per cent from the September figure.

Average weekly earnings totaled \$83.39. This was \$4.73 more than it was a year previous.

The area includes Multnomah, Clackamas and Washington counties, and Clark County, Wash.
