East Soon To Get First Show By Russell

SAN FRANCISCO — The East Coast and assorted way points are in for their first look at Bill Russell in the next couple of weeks and in the opinion of Western basketball fans will get an eyeful.

Big Bill is the 6-10 All-America center who led the University of San Francisco to the national collegiate cage championship a year ago. At the rate he's started this season—just a shade under a point a minute for the time he's played—he's even better now.

Russell earned his All-America label a year ago during an almost completely backyard schedule. The fastest USF got away from home, aside from the NCAA finals at Kansas City, was a holiday tournament at Oklahoma City.

This year the Dons are down for a transcontinental tour. They take off Wednesday for Chicago and a four-team tournament Dec. 16-17. They're due at Wichita, Kan., three days later and at New Orleans on Dec. 23. Then to New York City and the annual Holiday Festival at Madison Square Garden.

Coach Phil Woolpert figures his squad, rated first in this season's initial Associated Press poll, is ready for the trip. The Dons have added three victories to the string of 26 they compiled last season and reserves have seen almost as much action as regulars.

Russell personally is thriving on the rule change which widened the free throw lane to 12 feet. He has scored 59 points in the 61 minutes he has played in easy triumphs over Chico (Calif.) State, Southern California and San Francisco State. Last year, after three games, he had 80 points but had played 96 minutes.

The big center still excels at his stuff shot in which he jumps high above the basket and rams the ball down through the net, frequently with enough force to give it a 10-foot bounce. His goal tending hasn't suffered appreciably, either, since he's fast enough to get into and out of the lane in plenty of time.

NEW STATISTIC

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. — Buddy Spillman, St. Joseph Gazette statistician, kept his eye on the ball, if not the game, Wednesday night as Trenton (Mo.) met Highland (Kan.) in the St. Joseph Junior College basketball tournament.
