



Rogers To Stay On Job Until Successor Found

SALEM — A. A. Rogers, 74, state superintendent of banks since 1939, will remain on the job until the State Banking Board finds a successor, he told the board Monday.

Rogers said he wants to retire "because I'm at the age where I think I should."

Members of the board are Gov. Paul Patterson, Secretary of State Earl T. Newby, and State Treasurer Sig Unander.

Ike Spending Yule Holiday In Capital

WASHINGTON — President Eisenhower moved up his plans by a day and flew back to the capital from Gettysburg, Pa., Tuesday for the Christmas holidays. Mrs. Eisenhower was to follow later by automobile.

At Gettysburg, Eisenhower, looking cheerful, talked briefly with his pilot and Air Force aide, Col. William G. Draper, after he drove up.

It was cold and crisp, but there was a bright sun.

The cold weather is a major factor in the decision of his doctors to fly him to a warmer climate after Christmas. The time for that is not yet decided definitely.

Before he flew out of Gettysburg, Eisenhower held a previously scheduled meeting with Dillon Anderson, his special assistant for national security matters.

Arriving at the White House, the President went to his office to attend to some official business. No appointments were scheduled.

The President will confer at the White House with Secretary of State Dulles and meet at 2:15 p.m. Thursday with the National Security Council.
