

Northwest Delegates Split On Party Lines In Response To President's Message

WASHINGTON 56—With one eye apparently on this fall's elections, Pacific Northwest members of Congress split generally according to party in reaction to President Eisenhower's State-of-the-Union message.

It sounded good to Republicans; Democrats were dubious.

Sen. George D. Nelson, typified Democratic reaction. He said the message "expresses great faith but is regrettably deficient in works."

Morse said the message "promises much," but added:

"This administration has yet to demonstrate that it will do anything but continue its programs of big business-banking favoritism, while the general public interest receives lip service."

A contrasting view came from Rep. C. R. (Doc) Johnson, who said the message was "a good one." He said he was "glad that the Eisenhower administration has been able to devote its attention to the specific needs of Eastern Oregon and to help us get the power we need when we need it and not after a long, long wait."

Sen. Neuberger (D-Ore.), who debated the message of the State-of-the-Union message in the Senate, said the message was "a good one" and that the administration has always supported Democratic programs on human needs.

Rep. Ellsworth (R-Ore.) viewed the message as "excellent" and said he was "glad to see the President's further recommendations on farm and other specific programs."

He said he was "glad to see the President's recommendation of the need for construction and development (of resources) and the need for the use of non-federal money."

Rep. Westland (R-Wash.) said the President was asking a continuation of the program "already started" by the administration. He expressed gratification over reference to the balanced budget but said he was "not sure" that the proposed increases in appropriations.

Rep. Green (D-Ore.) said he considered the message's "great single omission" to be its sentence reference to problems of elderly persons. She added, however, that she was "encouraged" to believe that the program in its major essentials is one on which a Democratic Congress can agree.

Rep. Norblad (R-Ore.) said he was grateful the President did not adopt the political expedient of asking a tax cut before a balanced budget is assured and payment is made on the national debt.

Rep. Don Magnuson (D-Wash.) said the message "held out the same old half loaf" on resource development, reiterating the "inadequate partnership program" warmed over for 1956 consumption.

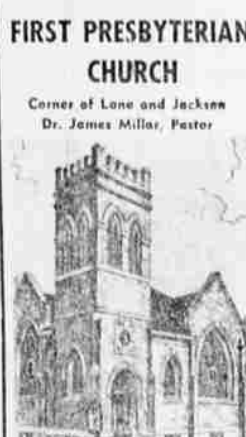
