**Jordan Lifts Curfew Six Hours Wednesday**

AMMAN, Jordan (AP)—The curfew imposed on Jordan last Saturday was lifted for six hours Wednesday, but was clamped on again Wednesday afternoon until further notice.  
Troops still guard the capital's public buildings but tension has decreased and most shops reopened when the curfew was lifted. All traces of Saturday's rioting have been cleared away. Warnings have been posted that any attempts at public gatherings will be dealt with severely.

**Red China Radio Says U. S. Should End Force**

TOKYO (AP)—Red China's Peiping Radio declared Thursday recent U.S. activities on Formosa "show clearly it is the United States itself which should renounce the use of force."  
The broadcast was, in effect, a reply to U.S. Secretary of State Dulles' statement last fall that Red China should renounce the use of force as the first step toward discussing vital issues at the Geneva talks between U.S.S. and Red Chinese ambassadors.  
"The United States side, while raising the question of renunciation of force, at the same time stepped up its military activities and armed threats in the Taiwan (Formosa) area," Peiping complained.  
Stocks of corn in the United States amounted to more than a billion bushels as of Oct. 1, 1955.
