Demo Senators Seek Firm Foreign Policy

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sen. Sparkman (D-Ala.) said Monday Congress "may have to rewrite" the administration's foreign policy program to make it more effective and to "end uncertainty and confusion." Sparkman, a member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, said he thought most Democrats want to present a united bipartisan front, "but the program needs restudy, and it may need rewriting." "It is hard to put your finger on just what the policy is," Sparkman told a reporter. In a separate interview, Committee Chairman George (D-Ga.) said recent Russian moves have "tended to put us too much on the defensive." "We should have a positive, aggressive and definite program," he added.

Wide Variety Meat Specials In Food Stores

Housewives will find a wide variety of meat specials at the nation's food stores this weekend. Beef, lamb, pork, hams and chickens will be featured by one big chain or another in major areas of the country. Various types of beef and steak will be sold at just about the same prices as a week ago, despite a gradual rise in the wholesale market which is expected to be reflected at the retail level shortly. The stiffening in the wholesale market is attributed to a combination of the weather and the greater demand for beef products after the holidays. Some chain is marking down price tags on pork chops, leg of lamb and chickens by 2 to 6 cents a pound in some cities. The same firm is hiking veal chops by 15 cents a pound in New York and by 9 cents a pound in Washington. But prices are falling across the country in other meats. Generally higher in recent weeks, reductions of from 5 to 13 cents a dozen are common in several major cities. Potatoes, onions and iceberg lettuce are regarded as outstanding buys in vegetables. Lettuce and leeks are turnips, celery and beets. Higher-priced vegetables include beans, cucumbers, radishes, egg-squashes, peppers, broccoli, mushrooms, cauliflower and cabbage. In fruit, tangerines are classed as about the best values. Other good buys are apples, grapes, grapefruit and Emperor oranges.

Towering Cedar Will Be Tallest Totem Pole

VICTORIA, B.C. (AP)—A towering cedar tree which will become the world's tallest totem pole was felled in a forest north of here Monday. The tree, 150 feet high and weighing nine tons, will be towed to Victoria where it will be carved by the Indian father-and-son team of Mungo and David Martin. The finished totem will be erected on the Strait of Juan de Fuca.
