

McClellan Plans To Plug Loophole In School Grants

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sen. McClellan (D-Ark.) declared that Congress should "plug the loopholes" through which he said Communist-tainted schools have received millions of tax dollars for training veterans.

McClellan heads the Senate Investigations subcommittee, which heard three school officials refuse to say yesterday whether they ever had been Communists. All three said they are not now.

McClellan announced he has ordered a bill drafted to bar Communist-owned private schools from receiving tuition payments or other financial benefits from federal agencies in connection with the GI Bill of Rights training program.

He said that when hearings resume this week the subcommittee will try to find out whether the Veterans Administration, as it contends, lacks authority to refuse to let veterans enroll at the government's expense in schools owned by Reds.

Three witnesses invoked the Fifth Amendment's guarantees against possible self-incrimination yesterday in refusing to say whether they had been Communists in the past. They were M. Michael Freedland, part owner of the Radio Television Technical School in Allentown, Pa.; and Burne Hogarth and Silas Rhodes, owners of the Cartoonists and Illustrators School, Inc., of New York City. All testified they are not Communists now.

Military Building Plan Includes Northwest Jobs

WASHINGTON (AP)—The military building program submitted to Congress last week by the Defense Department includes \$36,801,000 for projects in the three Pacific Northwest states.

The totals by states include: Washington, \$18,081,000; Oregon, \$14,628,000; Idaho, \$13,479,000.

With the exception of \$3,022,000 for the Army at Ft. Lewis and \$1,000,000 for the Navy's ammunition depot at Bangor, near Bremerton, all the major items in all three states are for Air Force developments.

The project requests by states: WASHINGTON—Army: Ft. Lewis, \$3,022,000. Navy: Supply depot, Seattle, \$1,000,000. Air Force: Whidbey Island, \$14,628,000; ammunition depot, Bangor, \$1,000,000; communication station, Seattle, \$43,000.

OREGON—Army: Unatilla Ordnance Depot, \$258,000. Air Force: Klamath Falls Municipal Airport, \$13,000,000; Greater Portland area, \$13,308,000.

IDAHOO—Air Force: Mountain Home AFB, \$2,064,000; national aircraft test station, Idaho Falls, \$11,415,000.

PORTLAND (AP)—A man who threatened to blow up a bank in downtown Portland, failed in a holdup try here Saturday.

Robert R. Runyon, assistant manager of the Metropolitan branch of the U. S. National Bank, said the man "didn't look desperate enough," and so he refused to give him the money which the man had demanded in a note.

The man then ran out the door, Runyon said.

BLM Plan To Ban Mining Blocked By Chambers

GRANTS PASS (AP)—Grants Pass and Josephine County Chambers of Commerce have blocked Bureau of Land Management plans for an immediate ban on mining in a large block of federal lands.

The bureau said it wished to withdraw from mining all federal lands for a distance of one-half mile on each side of the Rogue River from Prospect to Agness, a distance of 120 miles.
