

Douglas Co. Court Approves Ordinance Changing Names Of 53 Streets Near Roseburg

The Douglas County Court Tuesday approved in a county ordinance the change of some 53 street names in the central part of the county.

The streets mostly are located near Roseburg, but some are in the Green district and near Winston.

The ordinance was signed after presentation by the County Planning Commission which is attempting to systemize addresses through the central part of the county.

The new addresses all bear relationship to the new addresses in Roseburg so that if the area ever becomes completely urban, street numbers and names would be in consecutive order.

At the same time, in the same ordinance, the court rejected the proposed changing of three street names.

One was the suggestion that Diamond Lake Boulevard (formerly Second Avenue South and North Umpqua Road) should be known as Diamond Lake Boulevard clear

to Steamboat, about 40 miles to the east.

Another ruled out the designation of Garden Valley Road to Garden Valley Boulevard.

The third proposal rejected was the renaming of Vernon Lane, north of Garden Homes, to NW Lynwood Drive.

These are the new names which were accepted. Some other streets in this vicinity may bear similar names. Location is denoted generally by the designation of the quadrant in which they lie: NW, NE,

SE, SW and W.

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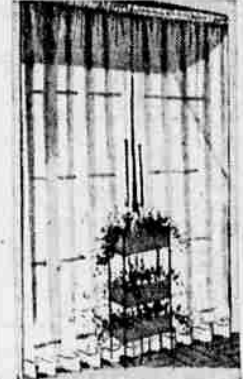
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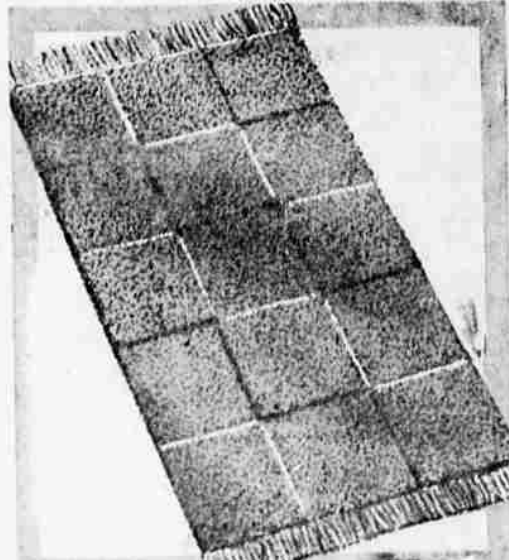
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Benefit Amateur Talent Show Stated At CV Hall

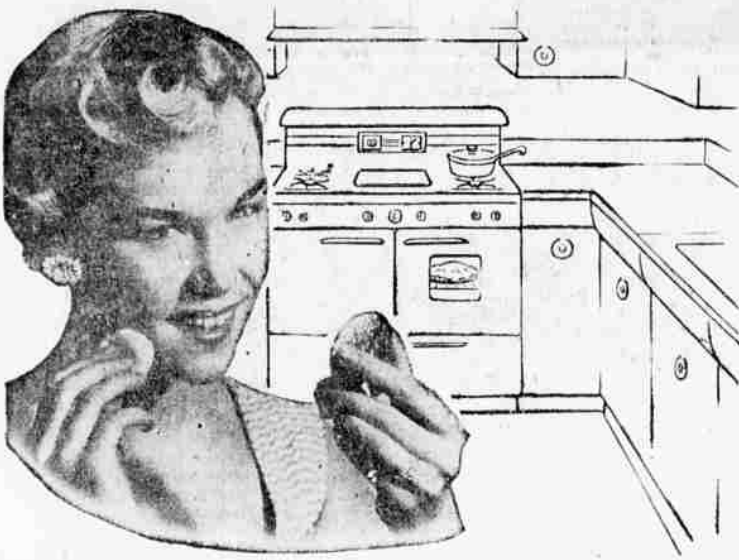
