

Prices Of Most Products Of Farms Has Improved, Agriculture Dept. Reports

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Agriculture Department said Tuesday that prices of most farm products have improved slightly in recent weeks to halt a five-year decline.

In a report on the market outlook for agricultural commodities, the department said prospects are that farm product prices in the early months of this year will average somewhat above the low levels reached in December.

A 7 per cent drop in the general level of farm prices last year deepened the political controversy over farm policy and it now shapes up as a possible major issue in the November elections.

The department gave no specific

figures on price improvements this month. A formal report giving these prices as of mid-January will be issued Jan. 31.

The department did say, however, that January improvements came after seasonal peaks in marketings of products had passed.

Price declines last year were said by the department to have been large for hogs, and substantial for some feed grains, oilseeds, potatoes and cattle.

On the other hand, it said prices of eggs were substantially higher at the end of the year and that moderate gains were made for other poultry products, vegetables and tobacco. Dairy prices held about unchanged.

In discussing recent developments in farm product markets, the department said prices of hogs increased an average of 5 per cent at Chicago during the first half of January. Cattle prices were said to have increased about 1 per cent at the same market.

The department said preliminary figures indicated farmers received \$29,200,000,000 in cash from marketings of farm products last year. This was a decline of 3 per cent from 1954.

No figures were given, however, on farm production costs for the year. Farmers' net income—the amount left after paying production and other costs—has been estimated at \$10,600,000,000, down about 10 per cent from 1954.

First Ships Of New German Navy To Be Ready In March

BOON, Germany (AP) — The first ships of the new German navy will be ready in March.

Within four years, the Germans expect to put 170 fighting ships on the seas as their naval contribution to the Atlantic Alliance.

Cont. Karl Adolf Zenker, chief of the navy department in the defense ministry, says this force will pack a powerful punch through its destroyers and small submarines.

The first ships flying the black-red-gold flag of West Germany will be minesweepers. Operating with German crews under command of the U.S. Navy for several years, they are sweeping World War II mines from the shipping lanes of the North Sea and the western Baltic. When assigned to the German navy, they will continue to destroy old mines that year after year still take a toll.

Hollywood Given Permit To Brighten Sidewalks

HOLLYWOOD (AP) — The sidewalks are going Hollywood.

Plans to install brightly colored, glittering sidewalks on parts of Hollywood Boulevard and Vine Street were approved by the Los Angeles Board of Public Works.

Sidewalks made of squares of buff and brown cement will be set off by an aquamarine trim. They'll be impregnated with an abrasive material to add sparkle and keep folks from slipping.

West Germany has asked the United States for the loan of 12 destroyers for six years—or until the Germans can build their own.

Bonn also has asked Britain to sell six frigates as training ships.

The exact number of destroyers planned for the new navy is an official secret. But defense ministry sources say there will be around 60 organized in 10 squadrons. The destroyers will be small—about 2,200 tons.

Submarines will be limited to 300 tons in size, Zenker says they will be able to travel submerged for 10 days. They will be mainly for reconnaissance or surprise raids on enemy supply lines.

The navy also will include anti-submarine and anti-aircraft escort vessels of about 1,400 tons, motor torpedo boats, landing craft, supply ships and training ships.

It will have a small antisubmarine and reconnaissance air force. The naval pilots will be trained in the United States.

About two-thirds of Germany's naval strength will be based in the Russian-dominated Baltic Sea.

Navy headquarters will be at Kiel, the famous base of the Kaiser's massive navy.

Informed sources say the top naval chief with the title of Inspector will be Vice Adm. Friedrich Ruge. He was naval adviser to the late Field Marshal Erwin Rommel when Rommel was building the "Atlantic Wall" to repel the allied invasion of France.

Visit In Cottage Grove

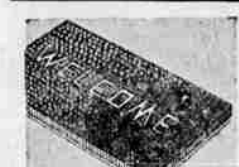
