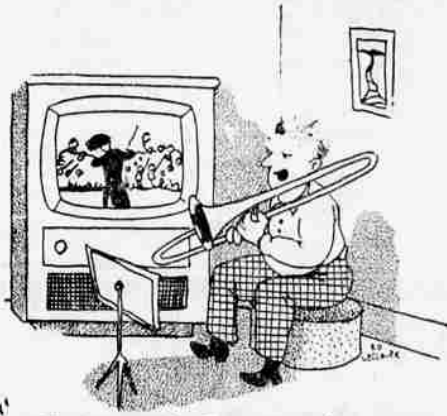


Old Photo Shows Roseburg's First Scout Troop s



ROSEBURG'S FIRST Boy Scout units, Troops 1 and 2, posed for a brownstone photo by the late Charles Clark of Clark's Studio on May 23, 1919. A print owned by Mrs. Story lies was rephotographed for this reproduction. The picture was snapped at Kane and Oak streets where the Catholic Church now stands. The site formerly was a carnival grounds, and the troops patrolled it for a week each year. Growth Of Scouting Is Shown



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The tremendous growth of scouting throughout the world is exemplified by the fact the Oregon Trail Council now has nearly 10,000 active scouts and leaders.

The old council, which included Douglas and Coos counties, had only about 500 in 1919, when the picture above was taken. The Oregon Trail Council comprises six counties.

This comparison was made by Bill Searth, Douglas Fir District executive, in connection with the 49th anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America and Boy Scout Week, Feb. 6-12.

The Douglas Fir District, part of the Oregon Trail Council, now has 1,383 active scouts and more than 500 adults. There are 30 units (cubs, scouts and explorers). Sponsors include churches, schools, fraternal organizations, granges, clubs, and so forth.

Despite the impressive number of units and scouts, Searth reports there is a very marked need for sponsors of new units. Many other boys in the district want to take part in the program — more than can now be handled.

Headquarters for the Douglas-Coos council of old were at Roseburg. Now, Oregon Trail Council headquarters are in Eugene. This year, however, a Roseburg man is council president. He is John Todd, who has been a scout leader for many years.

New Housing Measure Increases Loan Period

WASHINGTON (AP) — An omnibus housing measure introduced in the Senate Monday would open the way for 40-year F.H.A. loans and set aside a million dollars a year for training of professional city planning and housing technicians. The bill was the joint effort of Sens. Magnuson (D-Wash.) and Lehman (D-N.Y.).

Magnuson said the million dollars would go to the National Science Foundation, for the next 10 years to set up scholarships.

The measure, he said, also contains provisions liberalizing loans for farm housing and housing for the aged.

FUND BUILT HIGHER

The Neal Children's Fund has been built up to \$3,874.90, according to W. E. Garrison, one of the trustees of the fund.

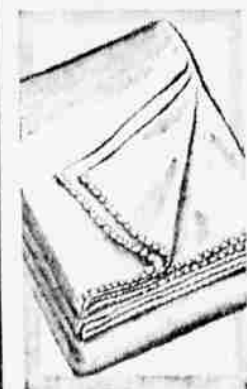
