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Medical Society Votes Against Funds For Clinic

PORTLAND (AP)—The Oregon State Medical Society's governing council has recommended against a \$37,000 application by the University of Oregon Medical School for federal funds to be used in remodeling the school's outpatient clinic.

Under normal procedures approval by the medical society would be necessary. A committee of the council voted 3-2 Saturday to recommend that the medical society approve the application for federal funds available under the Hill-Burton Act. The council, however, turned this down and accepted the minority view.

News of the decision was first disclosed in the Wednesday Oregonian which said the society's action came "in its continuing feud with the University of Oregon Medical School."

A society spokesman said that the primary reason for refusing approval was the fact that a survey by the State Board of Health showed the state's real need is for nursing homes, not outpatient clinics.

This, the spokesman said, was the "primary consideration" in deciding against recommending that federal funds be sought. The application, if one is made, will be by the State Board of Health which conducted the survey to determine the state's principal health service needs. The

board's advisory committee will meet May 8 to discuss applications and the medical school's presumably will come up at that time. The Board of Health normally does not approve medical
