

Teachers Becoming Scarcer, Educators Learn At Session

The nearly 2,500 educators attending the recent annual convention of the Inland Empire Education Assn. in Spokane learned that teachers are becoming a scarce commodity.

In Bakersfield and Kern County, Calif. Asked why the superintendent said salary offers from the trio surpassed others, Portland public school teachers have a salary schedule maximum of \$8,600; Kern of \$7,700; and Bakersfield of \$7,200.

A news story coming from the conference quoted the findings of one high school principal. He needed one teacher, interviewed 40 prospects and offered a \$4,100 starting salary. He received no acceptances.
