Maggie Jane Davis of Elkton died at a rest home near Eugene April 17 at the age of 77.

She was born Maggie Jane Schad, August 10, 1878, at Elkton, and was married at Roseburg May 16, 1900 to Ferney Davis, who survives her.

With the exception of a few years spent in Nevada, Mrs. Davis had spent her entire life in the Elkton community.

Funeral services will be held at the Christian Church in Elkton Friday at 2 p.m. The Rev. Philip Ryan will officiate with vault interment in the Elkton Cemetery. Mills Funeral Service of Drain is in charge of arrangements.

Subversion Trial Ends With Death

JAKARTA, Indonesia (AP) — The 14-month subversion trial of retired Dutch naval Capt. Leon M. Jungschlager ended Thursday with his death in a Jakarta hospital. Jungschlager, for whom the death penalty had been asked, suffered two strokes early Thursday and never regained consciousness. A Catholic priest administered the last sacraments to the former chief of military intelligence in the Netherlands Indies. His wife was at his bedside.

Jungschlager, 53, was accused of aiding the fanatic Darul Islam, a Moslem movement dedicated to overthrow of the Indonesian government. The Indonesian prosecutor demanded the death penalty.

The Dutchman steadfastly insisted on his innocence.

The case had been a major cause of friction between the Indonesian and Dutch governments. The Dutch charged the accusations were trumped up and that Jungschlager was not being given a fair trial.

Funeral Services Held For Former Resident Here

Funeral services will be Sunday at Mojave, Calif., for Roy D. Long, 56, former Roseburg resident. He died April 14 of a heart attack at Tehachapi, Calif.

He moved to California about three years ago. Prior to residing in Douglas county, he was a Lebanon resident.

Survivors include three sons, Emmett L. of Eureka, Charles A. of Roseburg and Marvin L. of Grants Pass; his father, C. C. Long of Lebanon, and a brother at Tehachapi and sister at Lebanon.

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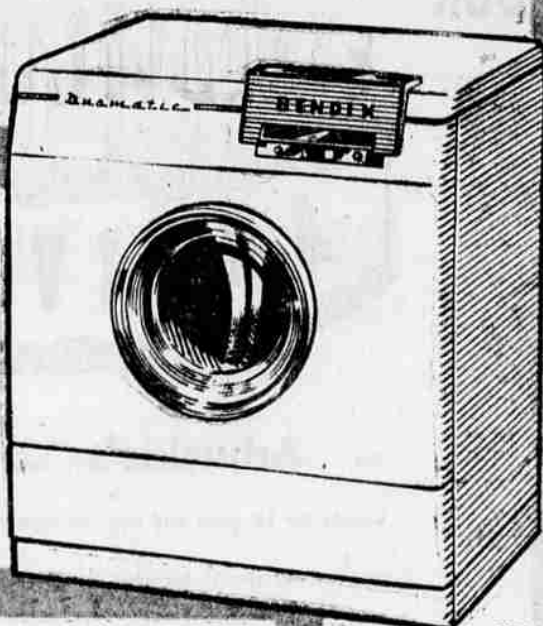
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
