Good Catches Reported On Astoria Waterfront

ASTORIA (AP) — Good catches were reported on the waterfront Thursday as fishermen brought in loads from their first runs of the new troll fishing season. Packing companies said early

loads at their docks indicated that the fishing was generally good all along the river. However, two hot spots were reported immediately off the Columbia River mouth and another around Willapa.

Big loads checked in by canneries included one of 10,000 pounds of Chinook, 7,000 pounds and 9,500 pounds. Several smaller craft docked loads of 700 pounds or better both at the Astoria and Warrenton canneries.
