**County Court Order Issues Deed To Timber**

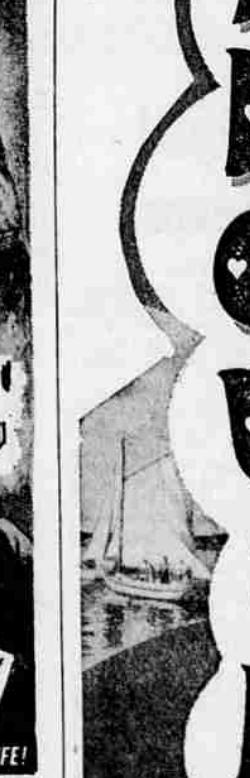

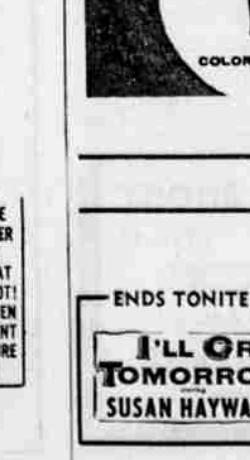
