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TOTS TO TEENS**  
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**Indian Gets Life Prison Sentence For Murders**  
WAUSAU, Wis. (AP) — A Winnebago Indian who said "voices of my ancestors" taunted him to kill was sentenced to life in state prison Monday for stabbing four relatives to death.  
Russell Monegar, 38, a World War II veteran, admitted the slayings May 3, but pleaded innocent and innocent by reason of insanity to four charges of first degree murder.  
Monegar testified he drank a home remedy made of mescal cactus buttons May 2 and had no control over his actions.  
A jury found him guilty Saturday and Circuit Judge Gerald Boileau imposed the four concurrent life terms after denying a defense motion for further mental observation.  
Slain in a Winnebago settlement near here were Monegar's wife, Ophelia, 33; her mother, Mrs. Elizabeth Long, 56; his niece, Iris Klabeck, 5 months, and Iris' half-brother, Phillip Garvin, 8.

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**Don't Be Fooled  
By Russian Talks,  
Adenauer Warns**

NEW HAVEN, Conn. (AP) — West German Chancellor Adenauer called on the West Monday not to relax "even for one moment" its vigilance in the face of friendly talk from Soviet Russia.  
Adenauer called the present tactics "more dangerous than the former aggressive conduct" of the Kremlin.  
He said the men in the Kremlin "are still not prepared to remove the main causes of the tension of the world."  
Adenauer's remarks were in an address at a luncheon given in his honor by the Board of Governors of Yale University.

Earlier in the day, the statesman received an honorary degree of doctor of laws during Yale University commencement exercises.  
Adenauer, on a week's visit to this country, arrived here from Greenwich, Conn., Sunday night.  
In his luncheon speech, the Chancellor said:  
"Throughout the world, the Soviets aggravate existing conflicts and endeavor to undermine the West's position in an unscrupulous manner. Above all they want to smash first the mighty protective shield of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and to drive the United States from Europe so that Europe will fall like a ripe fruit into the Soviet lap."  
Stalinism in New Guise  
The German leader asserted it is undeniable that the present Russian leaders have made an impression on some people by pushing Stalin from his throne—"after his death, it is to be noted."

But, he added, there are no signs to indicate the disavowal of Stalinism means the acceptance of those spiritual principles which are the foundations of the free world.  
"Instead," Adenauer declared, "There are only new forms and methods used by a new, more dexterous leadership in the Kremlin," in order to reach the old Bolshevik objectives with fewer sacrifices.  
Adenauer said it was undeniable that recently the cohesion of the West had weakened and "there are clear indications of a lack of coordination in its foreign policy."  
He added that NATO—further developed—is the proper instrument with which to tackle the new task of preventing Soviet moves to take advantage of weakness of the West.

**Guilty Pleas Entered  
To Gold Trafficking**

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Guilty pleas were entered in federal court here Monday by Elbert S. Osburn, 49, Cave Junction, Ore., and Guy Fye, 59, Auburn, Calif., who had been accused of illegal trafficking in gold.  
Osburn, a timber salesman, and Fye, a miner, pleaded guilty to a conspiracy count in a three-count indictment. They also were charged with violating the Gold Reserve Act by illegal sale and possession of gold. The court reserved a decision on a petition for dismissal of these counts.  
The court fixed July 3 as the date for sentencing. Maximum penalty is five years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.

**Search For 3 Missing  
Fishermen Called Off**

KLAMATH FALLS (AP) — Search for three fishermen missing near Bly was called off shortly after noon Tuesday when they walked into Bonanza.  
They said they spent the night in a stalled automobile, then hiked in for help.  
Both ground and air search had been started for the men, Tex Culley, 55; Jesse Kidd, 68; and Ed McIntosh, all of Klamath Falls.

**U. S. Plywood Corp.  
Earnings \$11 Million**  
NEW YORK (AP) — United States Plywood Corp. Tuesday reported its earnings for the year ended April 30 amounted to \$11,276,600, or \$5.22 a share, compared with \$7,838,100 and \$4.07 a share for the previous year.  
The company reported sales for the past year were \$202,832,409, compared to \$159,565,500 for the year before.  
For the quarter ended April 30, earnings were \$2,111,660, or \$1.18 a share, compared to \$2,094,034 and \$1.19 a share for the same period in 1955.

**17 Tiny Korean Orphans Arrive**

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Seventeen tiny Korean-American orphans arrived here Tuesday and 10 of them met their new parents.  
The group, shepherded by the Rev. Dr. Robert Pierce, toddled down the ramp from a PAN American Clipper to the cheers of a cluster of foster parents.  
Among the latter were actor Roy Rogers and his wife, Dale Evans, welcoming their fifth adopted child. Rogers now has a total of seven children. Two are by a previous marriage.  
The orphans—children of American servicemen and Korean girls—arrived from Honolulu on the last leg of a delayed flight from Seoul.  
The delay was caused by an outbreak of measles in Tokyo. The tots were quarantined for three weeks.  
The mass adoptions were sponsored by World Vision, Inc., which supports 101 orphanages in South Korea. Dr. Pierce is the founder and president of the organization.
