

Farms In Far West Are Getting Fewer In Number

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — Farms in the Far West are getting fewer in number but larger in size and the total land farmed is increasing. The federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco reported Tuesday. The bank said the number of farms decreased by 8 per cent between 1950 and 1954, the average size of the farm increased 14 per cent and the total land in farms increased 5 per cent. This trend was true in all seven states of the 12th District.

The average size of farms was 483 acres. The average value of land and buildings per farm in the district increased 52 per cent during the five-year period. The average value per acre was up 35 per cent.
