Westside Christian Church To Observe Third Birthday

Local Adventists Reach Drive Goal

Pastor Walter Riston of the Seventh-day Adventist Church recently expressed appreciation for the manner in which the community cooperated in the church's Missions Appeal. The church reached its goal of \$3000.

The funds will supplement the \$60,000,000 annual program of medical, educational, welfare and missions work conducted by the church in 183 lands.
