

Congress Is Given Preview Of Anticipated House Fight Over Hells Canyon Project

WASHINGTON — Congress has been given a preview of an anticipated House fight over legislation to authorize the Hells Canyon dam.

Majority and minority reports from the House Interior Committee, just off the presses, provide arguments for and against a proposed federal project in the Hells Canyon stretch of the Snake River along the Idaho-Oregon border, where the Federal Power Commission (FPC) has licensed three private utility dams.

If the House Rules Committee gives the expected green light, the arguments will be voiced and amplified on the House floor. Another debate is scheduled in the Senate on an identical bill.

The House Interior Committee approved the Hells Canyon bill Tuesday by a 15-13 vote. Proponents included 14 Democrats and one Republican. The opposition

was comprised of 12 Republicans and one Democrat.

The reports disagree, among many other things, as to whether the FPC did the right thing when it issued a license permitting the Idaho Power Co. to build three dams which would flood the federal site.

It would "reaffirm the jurisdiction of Congress over the development of the nation's water resources," the report said, "and reassert the congressional policy of securing the maximum development of water resources of the Columbia River basin in the best interests of the Northwest and the nation."

The federal project would fully develop the Snake River's power production potential, provide low-cost electric energy for industrial use and subsidize irrigation projects.

Language in the bill would provide "as complete and effective protection to existing and future water rights, as is within the power of Congress."

The minority report, signed by 12 Republicans, said: "The FPC, 'the agency charged by the Congress with the determination of what constitutes the best development of the river,' issued the license to Idaho Power 'to develop the entire head of the river' with three dams costing 133 million dollars."

"Federal development... would require appropriations... of 257 million dollars, exclusive of interest during construction amounting to 26 million dollars and exclusive of transmission lines estimated at 144 million dollars."
