Pulp-Paper Firm Wants To Lease Old Reservoir

SALEM — A pulp and paper firm wants to lease the old Tumalo Reservoir near Bend as a site for waste disposal, state engineer Lewis A. Stanley said here Wednesday.

E. A. Messer & Associates, Inc., Portland, representing a firm planning to construct a pulp and paper mill near Bend has made the inquiry, he said.

The reservoir is part of an irrigation development undertaken by the state in 1951. It failed to hold water despite several attempts to repair it. No water has been stored in the main part of the reservoir for many years.
