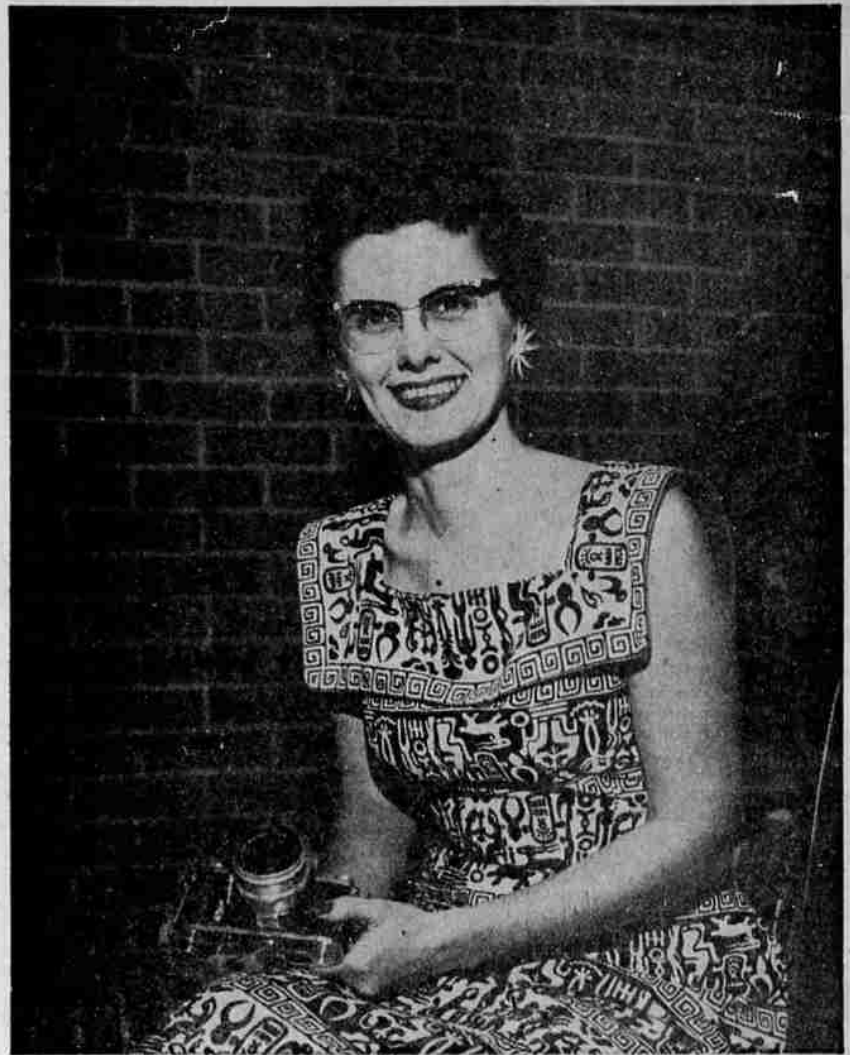


Teachers Attend Summer Sessions

AMONG THE MANY teachers of Roseburg School District No. 4 attending special summer school sessions and going to summer workshops are the five appearing on today's society feature page.

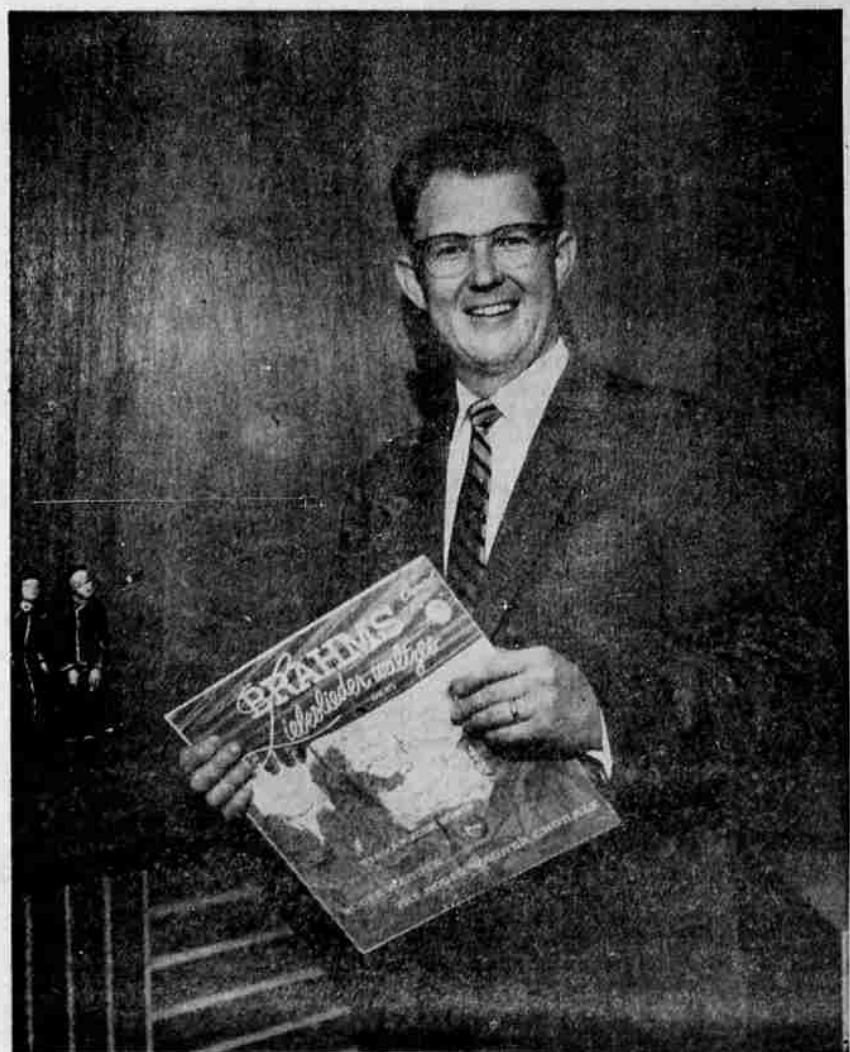
