Tavern Owners May Up Price Of Beer Five Cents

PORTLAND — Beer drinkers probably will have to pay a nickel more to quench their thirsts next week.

Tavern owners here were expected to boost the price of draft beer from 10 to 15 cents a glass and bottled beer may go up a nickel, too.

But John E. Tehan president of the local chapter of the Oregon Licensed Beverage Assn., says it isn't as bad as it sounds. He said he believes the draft beer price boost will be accompanied by more beer. Tehan expected taverns increasing the price to put about three more ounces of beer in the glasses.

The increase, Behan said, reflects a recent boost in wholesale beer prices brought on by a pay increase to workers and higher material costs.

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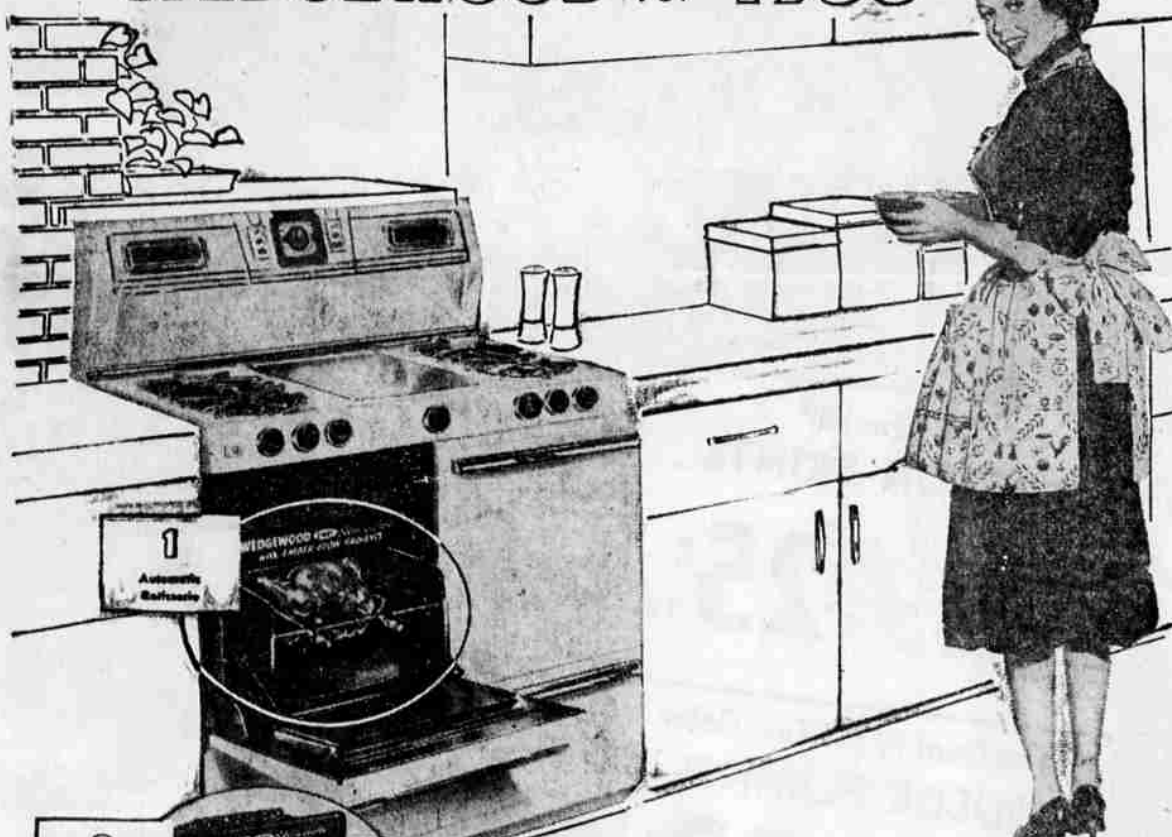
