### State Agriculture Dept. Finally To Have Own Home

By September the state department of agriculture will be in its own building for the first time in the department's 25 years of existence. Although the department's new home has been marked "Agriculture" for years, until recently only one-third of the building was occupied by the department.

It was originally known as the printing building and until last year the printing plant occupied the first floor and basement. As a result, the department was handicapped in certain phases of its work because of crowded conditions and the scattering of its headquarters operations in three buildings in Salem. Two of these buildings are former residences.

But the last legislature eased the situation and appropriated \$122,500 for remodeling this building for department use. James L. Payne was the architect selected by the Board of Control and R. L. Forster and Son are the contractors. The building's approximate 30,000 square feet enables it to give up the two leased residences.

The remodeled full basement will house the animal industry division, the federal-state brucellosis laboratory, storage and stock room, conference room and library. The federal veterinarian and his staff, formerly located in Portland, were moved to new basement quarters at material benefit to livestock and the department.

On the first floor will be the plant industry division including the federal-state shipping point inspection supervisor, the Salem area shipping point office and the walnut control board office. Also on this floor will be the director's office, division of market development, information representative staff, legal staff, business and personnel managers. Weights and laboratory and calibrating room adjacent to the service entrance. Clerical, stenographic and accounting personnel will occupy a large central portion of the first floor.

The foods and dairies, weights and measures division will be on the upper floor. Remodeling of the lation of new equipment will be completed in September. The plant pathology and entomology laboratories and plant pest and disease survey staffs will be added to this floor. An addition to it will provide space for the hop analysis laboratory.

Many individuals aided the department in obtaining adequate housing. They include the building advisory committee established by former Director Peterson, the State Board of Agriculture, farm organi-
