

Gordon Howard Featured In Concert Tonight

FCC Not To Interfere With Telegram Rates

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) announced Wednesday it will not interfere with Western Union's announced plan to increase interstate press telegram rates by about 8.22 per cent.

This means the rates will go into effect on Friday, Sept. 14, along with higher service rates between the United States, Canada and Mexico.

These new press rates come on the heels of an increase averaging 9.5 per cent on general commercial service messages within the United States, which became effective Aug. 26.

The overall increases are estimated to increase the Western Union Telegraph Co. revenues by about \$10,283,000, after allowances for some shrinkage in patronage as a result of the higher charges.

He won lead roles in the musical comedies "Kiss Me Kate" and "Carouse" and rounded his acting experience in straight dramatic parts. Simultaneously, he completed all work for a Master's degree in drama at the University of Oregon with the exception of his thesis. This past spring, as a production thesis, Howard produced a new manuscript treatment of the Faust legend, "The Magical History of Dr. Faustus." The tragic comedy was produced in the university's arena theater and played to full houses. Howard directed the
