

**ACQUITTED OF SEDITION**  
ROME (AP) — Gilberto Pontecorvo, whose atom-scientist brother Bruno quit England for Soviet Russia five years ago, was acquitted here of charges of encouraging sedition.

The government prosecutor had asked the Rome court to sentence him to a year in jail for an article in a Communist paper he publishes defending the holding of an unauthorized Communist demonstration.
